Sex was traditionally viewed as a cooperative venture, but we now know that a suite of evolutionary conflicts – both intrasexual and intersexual – underlie sexual reproduction. The cocktail of seminal substances transferred from males to females at mating are on the front line of these conflicts, and have far reaching consequences for the fitness of both sexes.
