

The freshwater pearl mussel Margaritifera margaritifera in the high North: ecology and ecosystem services

The freshwater pearl mussel is one of the many threatened freshwater mussels in Europe. The stronghold of this important flagship indicator species is in northern areas of Europe. Even north of the Arctic Circle strong populations occur.
