Two postdoctoral positions suitable for someone of background in molecular biology, biochemistry or biotechnology are available at the University of Notre Dame. The qualified applicants will have the Ph.D. degree in one of these disciplines. The tasks involve cloning genes, expressing proteins, purifying proteins and characterizing them by performing kinetics experiments. Knowledge of enzyme chemistry is desirable, but not a requirement. The projects deal with novel antibiotic classes and mechanisms of resistance to them. The work environment is multidisciplinary and the successful candidates will have the opportunity to work among a large group of scientists of similar interests within the group.
