FEDERICO CARPI was born in Bologna (Italy) on 1.15.1940 and is full professor of Civil Procedural Law at the Faculty of law of Bologna University.

He graduated from the University of Bologna with a degree in law in 1963. After graduation, he practiced in law in Italy. His academic career began at the University of Macerata and he subsequently held posts at the Universities of Cagliari and Ferrara. He joined the law faculty of Bologna University in 1979.
