FAQs INCOMING MOBILITY

- I have been nominated to the Faculty of Law UV. Who is my coordinator, and how do I contact him/her? Check the list of coordinators and their contact details on the following link: <u>https://go.uv.es/Dd0j40B</u>
- I am a student of Political Sciences but I have been nominated to the Faculty of Law. The Faculty of Law offers Degrees in Law, Political Sciences and Criminology, as well as Double Degrees in Law+Political Sciences, Law+Criminology and Business Administration+Law.
- I am an icoming student for one semester. Can I choose an annual subject and get half of the ECTS? No, first semester students can only choose first semester subjects. Second semester students can onlychoose second semester subjects. Only annual students can choose annual subjects, as well as first and second semester subjects.
- Can I choose any subject included in the study plan of my Degree?
 Yes, you can choose any subject included in your Degree, at any year, even optional subjects.

- > I am a Master student, can I choose Master level subjects?

No, if you have been nominated under a Mobility Agreement you can only choose Undergraduate level subjects. Master level requires a specific Bilateral Agreement, and we do not have any Master level Bilateral Agreements signed.

> Will I be allowed to enroll in all the subjects included in my L.A.?

Yes, you should be allowed to enroll in all subjects if enough places are available at the moment of the request, but maybe not in a specific group of your choice. Subjects have different groups, depending on the schedules and language (Spanish and Valencian for all the groups and English for some of them). Groups have a maximum number of places and some of them are highly demanded. No enrollment is possible in groups which have reached their capacity.

> I am interested in two subjects whose schedules overlap. What can I do?

Please note that all subjects include evaluable continuous assessment and therefore regular attendance is highly recommendable. However, if overlaps cannot be avoided, you can always talk to the Professors of the relevant subjects and explain them your situation.

> Will I be allowed to modify my L.A.?

Yes, you will have two opportunities per semester to modify your L.A. One deadline per semester will be conveniently scheduled. Changes outside such deadlines will not be accepted. Please contact the Erasmus coordinator of your home University before applying for the changes to make sure that they will be accepted. One unique request including all the changes will be highly appreciated.

Will my enrollment be changed automatically with the modification of my L.A.? No, you will have to fill in a specific form to change your enrolment

> Will I be allowed to cancel a failed subject in my L.A.?

No, the subjects included in your L.A. must be the same than the subjects on your enrollment and Transcript of Records.

> I have passed an exam, but I want to improve my grade. Can I make use of the second call to improve it?

No, if you have passed the exam you cannot make use of the second call.

You have two opportunities to pass an exam, but you can only make use of the second one in case you failed in the first call or you decided not to do it.

> Can I do my Traineeship together with my studies?

No, you cannot do your Traineeship while doing your studies at our University.

> Can I do my Final TFG (Degree Final Project/Research? together with my studies?

No, you cannot do your TFG/Research together with your studies in the framework of the Erasmus studies programme.

> Can I do a traineeship or a DFP/Research stay at your Faculty?

Yes, if you have NOT been nominated as an Erasmus student under a mobility bilateral Agreement. Erasmus traineeship programme managed from your Home University is allowed, as well as freelance stays. However, both possibilities are subjected to the support of a local supervisor (a lecturer attached to any of our Departments). Interested students are responsible of finding one.

I will not be able to be present at the date of the exam. Can I ask professors to change the date of my exam?

No, official dates for exams cannot be changed. Those dates are available since the beginning of the academic year at "Secretaría Virtual" in the platform. Check them before making plans or buying plane tickets.

> Can I choose my groups in English language?

We can only offer groups in English language in the Degree of Law
