

PhD Course in Psychological Sciences

The main goal of the 3 year PhD program in Psychological Sciences, at the University of Padova, is to train high-level researchers in the field of Psychological Sciences.

The program is designed to prepare psychologists to work effectively as researchers, college and university instructors, and professional research psychologists across diverse fields of research with particular emphasis on:

- Clinical and Experimental psychology
- Human life-span development
- Neuropsychology and cognitive psychology
- Social, cultural and group psychology
- Cognition
- Behavioural neuroscience
- Neuroimaging and computational neuroscience
- Evolution of mind and cognitive functions
- Language and psycholinguistics
- Consumer choice, behavioural economics, marketing

The course offers 13 fellowship positions including:

- a fixed topic fellowship supported by a grant from the Italian Government (Department of Excellence) to the Department of General Psychology;
- a fixed topic fellowship related to a high level apprenticeship contract.

All fellowships are open to both national and international students.

The supervisor of Doctoral students can be one of the approximately 60 faculty members, experienced researchers in different areas of psychology.
