

STUDENTS OF MEDICINE IMPORTANT WARNING:

INCOMINGS ERASMUS STUDENTS FULL YEAR STAY

- Just an elective subject per student and semester is allowed.
- Just a 3rd year subject per student and semester is allowed.
- In order to try to avoid overlaps you could choose main subjects from one block (4th or 5th) and just one from another. Other combinations would be accepted if don't have overlaps which prevent student to attend more than 20% of seminars. (The ORI will communicate if your proposal has overlaps over 20%)
- You can choose different main block per semester.
- If you enroll subjects from 5th block on first semester and 4th block on second, you can only choose 2 of this 3 subjects: 34473, 34482 and 34481.
- **Compatibility in timetable is not guaranteed if you choose subjects from different years**
