- Actividades de **demostración:** hasta el 50 %
- Gestión del consorcio: hasta el 100 %
- Otras actividades: hasta el 100%

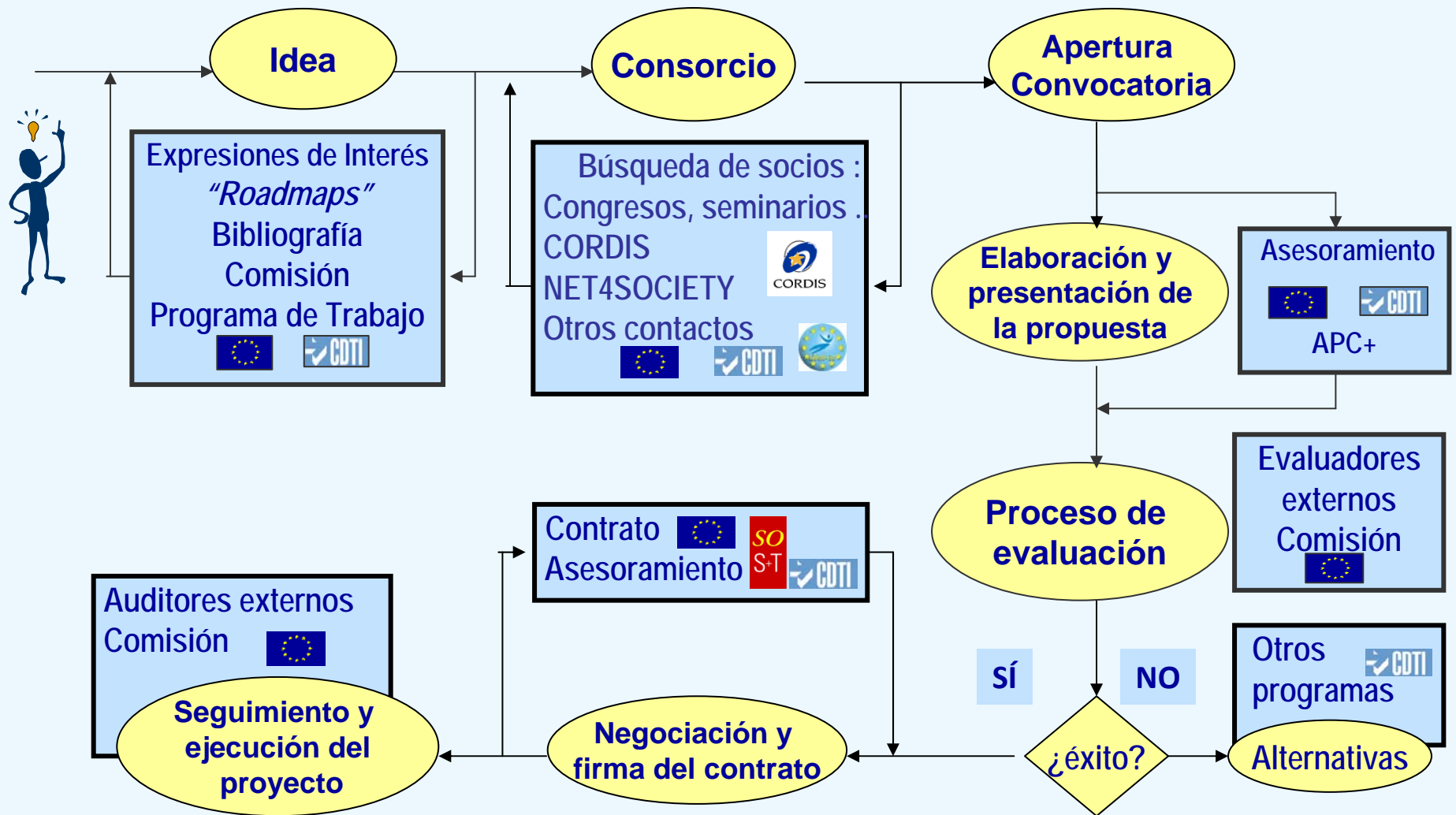

Motivation

Research under the SSH programme is intended to be policy and socially relevant i.e. to be able to inform policy and public debate and to identify and examine key issues and options, while not being driven by short-term policy priorities.

From 2010 onwards, research under the SSH programme will be following an overall integrated "Strategic Research Roadmap" covering the period 2011-2013. It enables a better and comprehensive planning and coordination for the research community as well as for the European Union policies.

Please note however that this Roadmap is purely indicative and subject to change. It is legally non-binding for the European Commission and only serves information purposes.

The roadmap is based on the objectives and activities set out in the Specific Programme "Cooperation". It takes into account the topics covered within previous work programmes and the funded projects within the activities respectively.

Furthermore current policy developments and policy needs (expressed for example through other Commission Services within the Inter-Service Consultations) are taken into account as well as significant societal and economic developments identified with the Expert Advisory Group.

In line with the new approach for the SSH Programme within each of the activities of the Specific Programme, the roadmap identifies major 'Societal Challenges' that have to be tackled in a medium to long term perspective 'Topics' that in general will be approached by small-medium scale focused research projects or coordination and support actions that strive at either addressing urgent needs or complementing the research agenda of the societal challenges.

Since research conducted under this programme is funded by public resources, its results should be as publicly and widely accessible as possible, thus the EU provisions for access to scientific information will apply. At the same time, due respect for ethical issues –including data protection, protection of private life and informed consent – will be required.

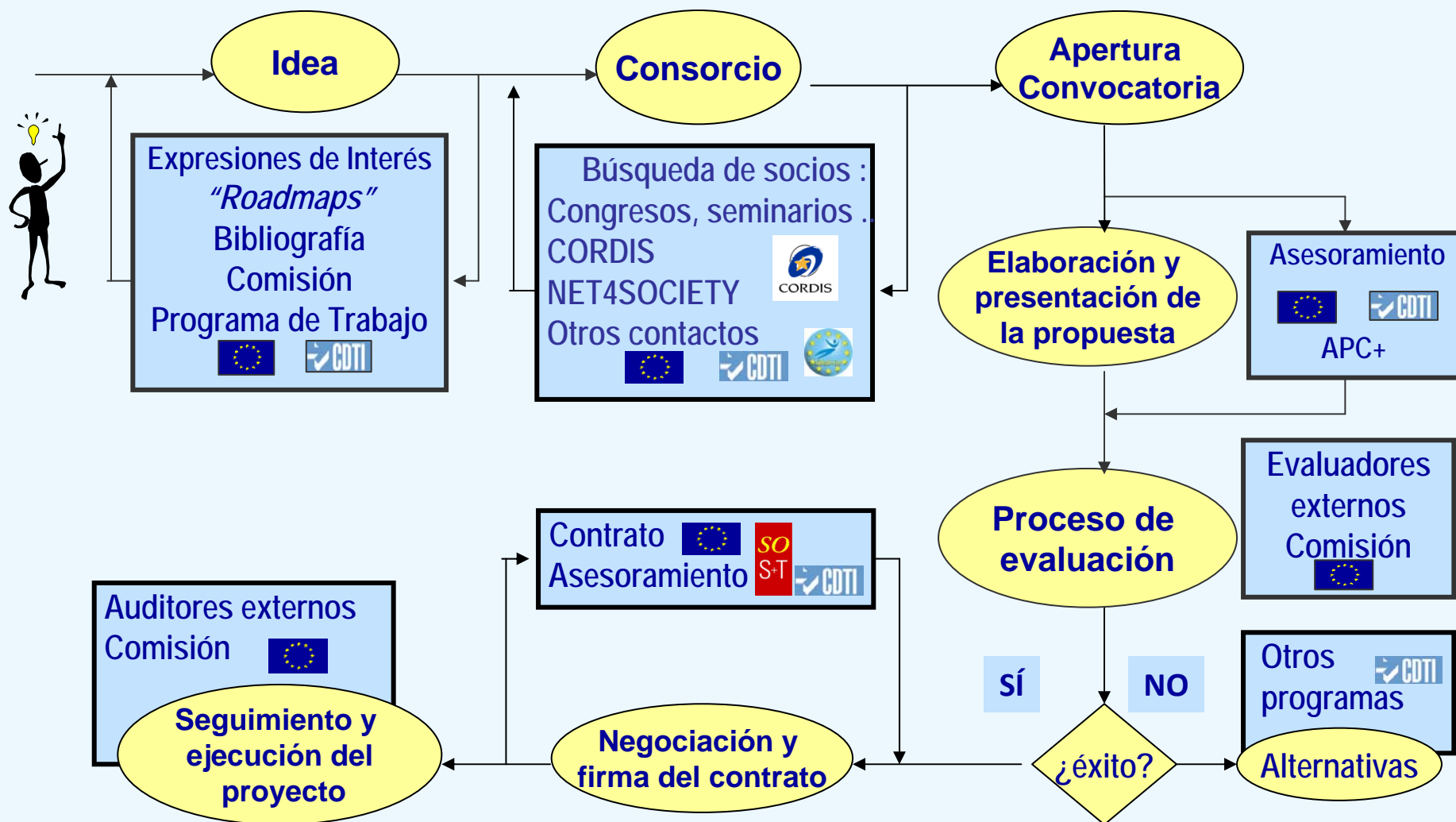

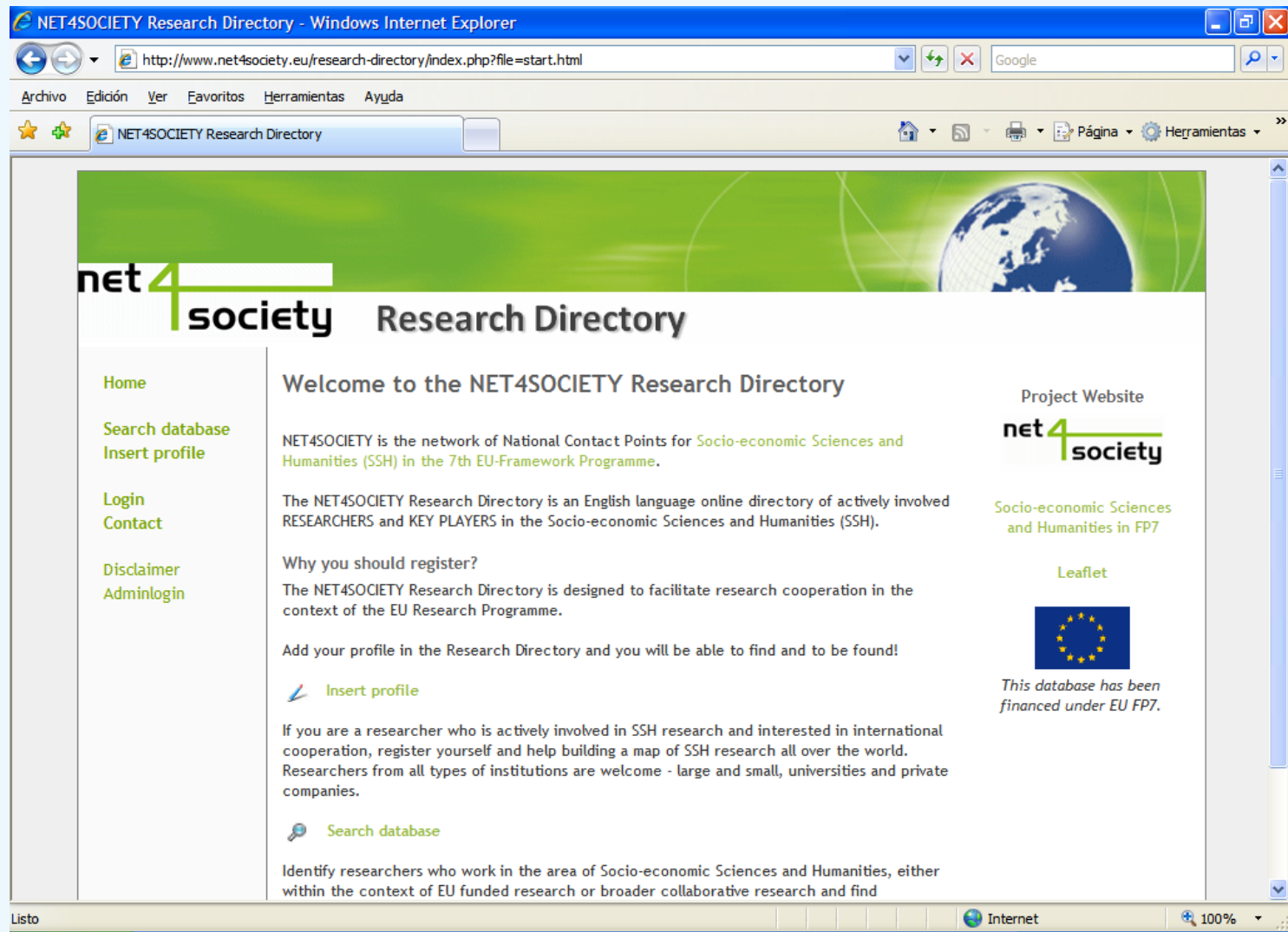

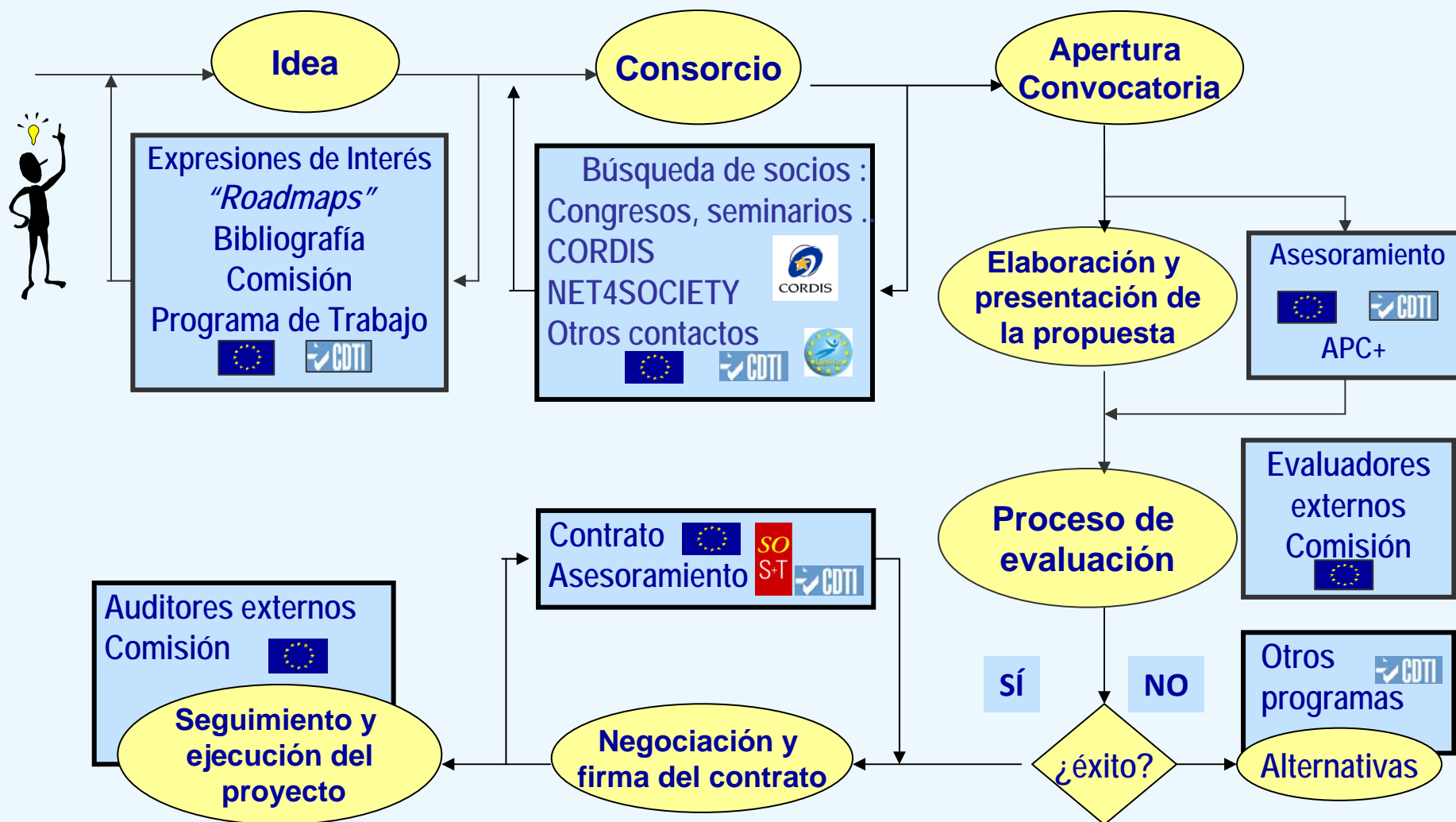

Preparación de la propuesta (1/4)

Paquete informativo

- **Folleto “FP7 in Brief”, “FP7 factsheets”**

Preparación de la propuesta (3/4)

PARTE A: Formularios administrativos (EPSS)

- A1->Información general de la propuesta: título y acrónimo, resumen, “*keywords*”
- A2-> Información sobre los participantes (nombre, dirección, tipo de institución...)
- A3.1 y A3.2 -> Desglose de costes por participante y tipo de actividad

PARTE B: Contenido científico-técnico (plantilla)

Deberá contener la siguiente información, que encontraremos en la Guía del Proponente (relacionada con los correspondientes criterios de evaluación):

- Calidad Científico y/o Tecnológica : objetivos, metodología y plan de trabajo
- Implementación: calidad del consorcio, experiencia de los participantes, asignación de recursos, estructura de gestión, etc).
- Impacto: contribución UE, impacto en relación con WP, disseminación y utilización de resultados (teniendo en cuenta a quién va dirigido cada resultado)

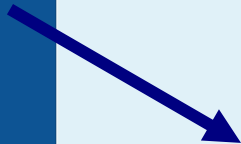

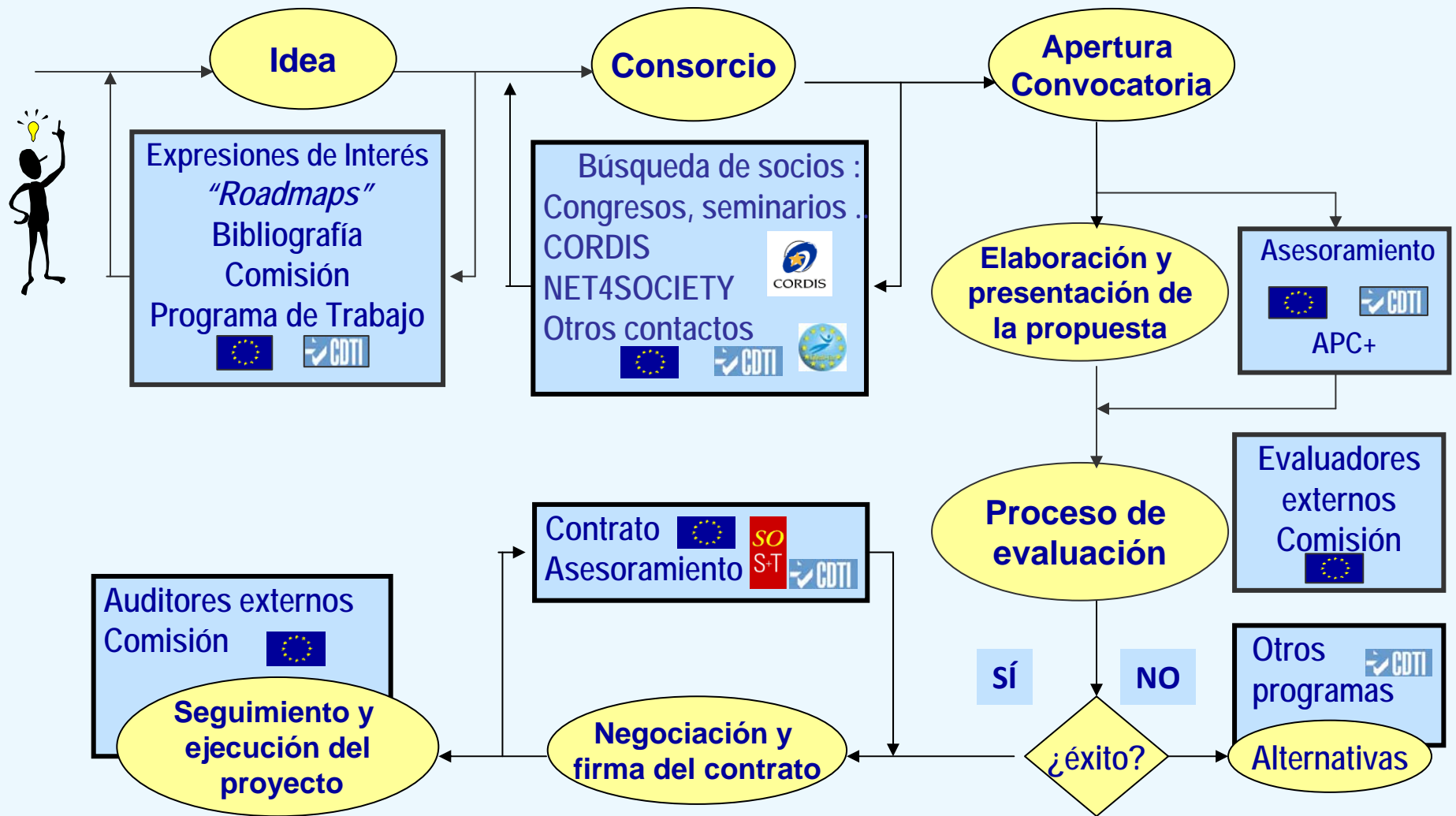

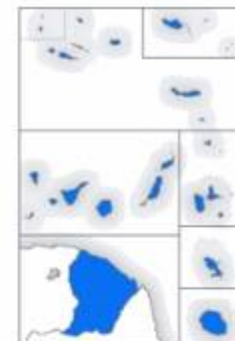

Special clause 39: adopted 20 August 2008

- “In addition to Article II.30.4, beneficiaries shall deposit an electronic copy of the published version or the final manuscript accepted for publication of a scientific publication relating to foreground published before or after the final report in an institutional or subject-based repository at the moment of publication.”
- “Beneficiaries are required to make their best efforts to ensure that this electronic copy becomes freely and electronically available to anyone through this repository:
 - immediately if the scientific publication is published "open access", i.e. if an electronic version is also available free of charge via the publisher, or
 - within [X] months of publication.”

Recomendaciones (1/2)

- **Leer y entender la documentación:** la idea tiene que encajar en el WP
- **Identificar el esquema de financiación y “*topic*” más adecuados**
- **Ponerse en el lugar del evaluador** (poco tiempo y mucho que leer):
 - Formato inteligible (estructura, índice, inglés claro y estándar, tamaño fuente, A4 y márgenes, figuras, tablas, etc.)
 - Propuesta concisa : ajustarse a lo que piden e “ir al grano”
 - El evaluador evalúa lo que lee, no asumir otra cosa
- **Cuidar el lenguaje:** parafrasear adecuadamente y dando valor añadido Programas de Trabajo, guía de evaluadores, otros documentos de referencia
- **Redactar pensando en :**
 - ¿Quién me va a evaluar? Lenguaje, contexto de Programa Marco
 - ¿Cómo me van a evaluar? Criterios de evaluación
 - ¿En que *topic* va a encajar mi propuesta?

Recomendaciones (2/2)

- Asegurarse de cumplir los requisitos de elegibilidad (incluyendo financiación)
- No dejar contradicciones o incoherencias evidentes que la puedan descalificar: repasarla antes de su envío
- Aprovechar (cuando las haya) guías de redacción basadas en buenas prácticas
- Solicitar a una tercera persona que evalúe la propuesta previamente
- Evaluar propuestas es la *MEJOR ESCUELA*: <https://cordis.europa.eu/emmf7/>
- No olvidar los aspectos “horizontales”: aspectos éticos, de género, apertura a la sociedad, interacciones con otros ámbitos, participación de terceros países


