About ERIC

The main objective of this project is to adapt two Computer Based Training Programmes for drivers to the Austrian, Spanish and Polish traffic and driving environment. Two CBTs have been developed by the DVR and the Berufsgenossenschaften (an insurance company) two years ago: one on fatigue and driving and one on driving physics. These CBTs have been translated and adapted in Spain, Poland and Austria. The acceptance of the learning tools have been tested in specific workshops and with enquiries of the workshop participants.

- To make public the provisional results of the project
- To create a debate on the target groups, the adaptation, the acceptance and the dissemination of the tools.
