

**AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITAT DE VALÈNCIA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF NANTES  
FOR THE DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMME  
IN THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN ECONOMICS FROM THE UNIVERSITAT DE VALÈNCIA AND THE  
BACHELOR'S DEGREE IN ECONOMICS AND MANAGEMENT SCIENCES AND THE CERTIFICATION OF THE  
1<sup>ST</sup> YEAR MASTER'S DEGREE IN ECONOMETRICS AND STATISTICS OR THE CERTIFICATION OF THE 1<sup>ST</sup>  
YEAR MASTER'S DEGREE IN ECONOMICS OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENT FOR SUSTAINABLE  
DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF NANTES**

Of the one part, the Universitat de València Estudi General (hereinafter referred to as UV), having its legal address at Avinguda de Blasco Ibáñez, 13, 46010 Valencia, with fiscal identification number Q-4618001-D and represented herein by its rector, Ms María Vicenta Mestre Escrivá, acting by virtue of Article 94 of the Statutes of the Universitat de València, which were approved by Decree 128/2004, of 30 July, of the Consell de la Generalitat (DOGV 2004/8213), amended by Decree 45/2013, of 28 March, of the Consell (DOGV 2013/6994) and entitled to enter into this agreement by virtue of her appointment by Decree 41/2018, of 6 April, of the Consell (DOGV 2018/8270).

Of the other part, the University of Nantes, having its legal address at 1, quai de Tourville BP 13522, 44035 Nantes Cedex 1 With fiscal identification number 194409843 and represented herein by its, President, Prof Carine Bernault acting by virtue of her appointment by Decree of 8<sup>th</sup> April 2021 published in the Official Journal n°0111 of 13<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

The parties to this agreement hereby

**DECLARE**

1. That the Universitat de València is a public university that, in accordance with Article 27.10 of the Spanish Constitution and with Organic Law 6/2001, of 21 December, on Universities, has its own legal personality and performs its functions independently of and in coordination with the rest of universities. Its services include providing public higher education and issuing official degree certificates that are valid throughout the national territory.
2. That the Universitat de València offers, among others, the qualification of Bachelor's Degree in Economics.
3. That the University of Nantes is a public establishment of a scientific, cultural and professional nature and has its own legal personality. Its services include providing public higher education and issuing official degree certificates that are valid throughout the national territory
4. That the University of Nantes offers, among others, the qualification of Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences [Licence Economie – Gestion] and the Master's Degree in Econometrics and





Statistics [Master 1 économétrie et statistiques, économétrie appliquée abbreviated ES EKAP] or the Master's degree in Economics of Energy and Environment for Sustainable development projects [Master 1 économie de l'énergie, de l'environnement et des transports, conduite de projet en développement durable, abbreviated EEET CODEME].

5. That both universities signed an agreement in 5 December 2011, and the two addenda signed on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2013 for the double degree programme in the Bachelor's Degree in Economics from the Universitat de València and the Bachelor's Degree in Economic and Master's Degree in Political and Economic Analysis from the University of Nantes.

The parties, acting in their aforementioned capacities, acknowledge the other's legal capacity to enter into this agreement according to the following

## CLAUSES

### 1. – AIM OF THE AGREEMENT

The aim of this agreement is to implement a double degree programme between the UV and the University of Nantes, by means of which the students enrolled will obtain the Bachelor's Degree in Economics from the UV and the Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences [Licence Economie – Gestion parcours analyse économique] and the certification of the 1<sup>st</sup> year Master's Degree in Econometrics and Statistics [Maitrise diploma, master 1 économétrie et statistiques, économétrie appliquée ES EKAP] or the certification of the 1<sup>st</sup> year Master's degree in Economics of Energy and Environment for Sustainable development projects [Maitrise diploma, master 1 économie de l'énergie, de l'environnement et des transports, conduite de projet en développement durable, EEET CODEME] delivered by the University of Nantes.

Participation in this double degree programme is open to students enrolled in the Bachelor's Degree in Economics at the UV or in the Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences at the University of Nantes.

To this end, this agreement specifies the general requirements for participating in this double degree programme. Likewise, it establishes the number of credits and the name of the modules or subjects of the curriculum that the students must take at each of the partner universities.

### TWO. – REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING THE DEGREES

Upon completion of the courses included in the double degree programme, each student will be awarded the official degree certificates of the double degree programme: the Bachelor's Degree in Economics from the UV [Grado en Economía] and the Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences [Licence Economie – Gestion] and the certification of the 1<sup>st</sup> year Master's Degree in Econometrics and Statistics [Maitrise diploma, master 1 économétrie et statistiques, économétrie appliquée ES EKAP] or the certification of the 1<sup>st</sup> year Master's degree in Economics of Energy and Environment for Sustainable





development projects [Maitrise diploma, master 1 économie de l'énergie, de l'environnement et des transports, conduite de projet en développement durable, EEET CODEME delivered by the University of Nantes.

Both degrees are official university degrees in the country of the issuing university and are accredited by the relevant national agencies.

In particular, students must complete at least 120 European credits (ECTS) at UV and at least 120 ECTS European credits (ECTS) at the University of Nantes, to obtain the Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences [licence Economie – Gestion] and the certification of the 1<sup>st</sup> year Master's Degree in Econometrics and Statistics or the certification of the 1st year Master's Degree in Economics of Energy and Environment for Sustainable development projects [maitrise diploma] from the University of Nantes and the Bachelor's Degree in Economics from UV based on mutual recognition of credits. .

Details of the modules and subjects that students must take at each of the partner universities are set out in Appendix I to this agreement.

In accordance with regulations of the UV, if the Degree Final Project is made at other university not at UV, it will be supervised by the coordinator of mobility in the Faculty of Economy at UV, who will be appointed by the Joint Monitoring and Control Committee, or will be supervised in IAE school of Economics and Management at UN, and recognised as equivalent to DFP.

### **THREE. – OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES**

The universities that sign this agreement are responsible for:

- implementing the training courses leading to the degrees according to the corresponding curriculum;
- safekeeping the students' academic records;
- recording and issuing the corresponding degree certificate.

### **FOUR. – EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS**

1. The universities agree to exchange a maximum of 4 new students per university each academic year within the framework of the double degree programme that is the object of this agreement.

2. In the event that there is an imbalance in the number of exchanges of double degree students it will be adjusted, during the term of this agreement, by double degree students or exchange students. But, in this case, the host university receiving more double degree students or exchange students will have the final decision on how many students beyond the required balance it is willing to accept during that academic year.





## FIVE. – STUDENT ADMISSION

1. At all events, participation in this double degree programme requires that applicants meet the entry and admission requirements for the aforementioned university degrees according to the regulations in force at each university.
2. Both universities are committed to selecting students wishing to participate in the double degree programme according to objective and specific criteria based on equality, merit and ability.
3. The requirements for participating in the double degree programme are:
  - For students of Bachelor's Degree in Economics [Grado en Economía] at UV:
    - To have passed 120 ECTS credits of the first and second year of the Bachelor's Degree in Economics at UV.
    - To be able to provide proof of a B2 level of French and English.
  - For students of Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences [licence Economie – Gestion] at University of Nantes:
    - To have passed 120 ECTS credits of the first and second year of the Bachelor's Degree in Economics and Management sciences [licence Economie – Gestion] the at University of Nantes.
4. Both universities agree to admit students nominated by the other university on a reciprocal basis, provided that they meet the requirements for entry and admission to the university degree in accordance with the regulations in force at each university.
5. After verifying compliance with entry and admission requirements, the host university shall go through all the formalities needed to complete the enrolment.

## SIX. – RECOGNITION OF SUBJECTS

Both universities shall recognise the subjects and credits passed and the competences acquired during the periods of study in the home and host institutions within the framework of the qualifications referred to in clause seven.

## SEVEN. – TABLE OF EQUIVALENCE

The parties agree on a table of equivalence of the marking and assessment systems of each institution, which is attached to this agreement as Appendix II. Any modification to this table must be validated by the person responsible for the programme at each institution.

## EIGHT. – PROMOTION OF STUDIES

1. Each institution shall include a description of the double degree programme under this agreement, including entry requirements, on its website.





2. Each party may use the name of the other party to promote the studies covered by this agreement.

#### **NINE. - FEES**

1. Payment of tuition fees for public services must be based on criteria of reciprocity. Double degree students will pay tuition fees at the home university and not at the host university. Therefore, students will be exempt from payment at the host institution except for administrative fees such as the issuance of the university card, school insurance and academic record management, university sports activities, which are to be paid by double degree students.
2. Travel expenses, accommodation, meals, teaching materials and other personal expenses must be borne by double degree students themselves.
3. Each student is responsible for their visa application and associated costs. If the student requires a confirmation of enrolment or a letter of invitation from the host university to obtain a visa or scholarship, these must be sent as soon as possible.
4. Each double degree student is required to obtain health care and repatriation insurance. The student is responsible for the costs of such insurance.
5. Students who complete the double degree programme regulated herein must pay the fees for issuing the degree certificates at both universities (if applicable).

#### **TEN. – DOUBLE DEGREE STUDENT SERVICE**

1. Double degree students are entitled to use the services of the host university necessary for completing their studies.
2. Each university, if it is necessary, will provide to the double degree students with the documents required to process entry visas. Through their International Office, they commit to provide useful information to incoming students and to assist them upon their arrival in adjusting to university life by providing services and information on orientation, registration, housing, social security and home language courses.
3. Both universities agree to communicate emergency situations involving their respective exchange students.
4. UV students going to UN should register on the Mobility Online Tool by 15<sup>th</sup> May of the preceding year.

#### **ELEVEN. – JOINT MONITORING AND CONTROL COMMITTEE**





1. A Joint Monitoring and Control Committee shall be set up to coordinate and monitor all matters relating to the implementation of this agreement.

This committee must be made up of two representatives from each partner university. The members of this committee are included in Appendix III to this agreement.

#### **TWELVE. - ACADEMIC AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS**

1. Double degree students are subject to the academic and disciplinary regulations of the host university during their stay.

2. Each university reserves the right to expel an exchange student if his/her conduct or work violates the academic or disciplinary regulations of that university. In all events, the host university must immediately inform the home university of this circumstance and the student may be expelled after the corresponding disciplinary inquiry has been examined.

#### **THIRTEEN. - TERM**

1. This agreement shall enter into force on the date of the last signature and shall remain in effect throughout four academic years including the years 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24.

The Master degrees awarded by the Université de Nantes, as mentioned above, are accredited by the French Ministry of higher education and research for the period 2017-2022 and are currently subjected to an accreditation for a new five-year period (2022-2027). The pursue of the double master degree program for the 2022/2023 and 2023-2024 academic years is submitted to the approval of the accreditation process, as mentioned above.

The agreement signed by both universities at 5 December 2011 will be ineffective by this current agreement.

2. This agreement may be extended once more, for an equal period, by written agreement between both universities, prior to the date of its termination.

#### **FOURTEEN. - EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION AND DATA PROTECTION**

1. Collaboration between the signatory parties involves the transfer and processing of personal data, so the parties commit themselves to complying with current legislation on data protection in French and in Spain, and to taking all relevant measures for such protection to be real and effective.

2. Each university shall be responsible for the data that it processes and for complying with the data protection regulations to which it is subject.





**FIFTEEN. – RESPONSIBILITIES**

1. The universities participating in this double degree programme act as independent legal entities so that each is responsible for the corresponding obligations towards its own staff.
2. This agreement is not exclusive, so each of the universities is free to establish double degree programmes with other universities.

**SEVENTEEN. - AMENDMENTS**

This agreement may be amended, before the expiry of its period of validity, by express mutual agreement, and any amendments shall be added as an addendum hereto.

**EIGHTEEN. - CAUSES FOR TERMINATION IN ADVANCE**

This agreement may be terminated in advance for any of the following reasons:

- a) For expiration of its validity.
- b) By mutual consent of the parties.
- c) At the instigation of one of the parties, by giving the other party no less than twelve months' express notice.





Early termination of this agreement for whatever reason shall not negatively affect the students that have started the course. Consequently, no student that has begun the double degree programme will be deprived of the opportunity to complete the programme, provided that completion is not delayed for more than three years from the start of the programme.

The parties hereto sign two equally valid counterparts of this agreement in English.
