**AGREEMENT OF INTERUNIVERSITY COOPERATION
FOR THE GRANTING OF A SECOND CYCLE DOUBLE DEGREE**

Between

Alma Mater Studiorum – Università di Bologna (hereafter referred to as “University of Bologna”) represented by its Rector Prof. Francesco Ubertini, Via Zamboni, 33 – 40126 Bologna- Italy

and

Universitat de València Estudi General (hereinafter referred to as UV), having its legal address at Avinguda de Blasco Ibáñez, 13, 46010 Valencia, with fiscal identification number Q-4618001-D and represented herein by its rector, Ms María Vicenta Mestre Escrivá, acting by virtue of Article 94 of the Statutes of the Universitat de València, which were approved by Decree 128/2004, of 30 July, of the Consell de la Generalitat (DOGV 2004/8213), amended by Decree 45/2013, of 28 March, of the Consell (DOGV 2013/6994) and entitled to enter into this agreement by virtue of her appointment by Decree 41/2018, of 6 Abril, of the Consell (DOGV 2018/8270)

Together named “the Parties”

Provided that

- 1. the Parties signed exchange and mobility agreements in the framework of the LLP-Erasmus Programme;**
- 2. University of Valencia awards the Master en Economía Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas) and University of Bologna awards the Laurea Magistrale in Management dell’Economia Sociale;**

3. the Italian Ministerial Decree “DM 270/04” allows Italian Universities to jointly grant degrees (2nd cycle) with other foreign Universities;
4. the Spanish Royal Decree 1393/2007 allows Spanish Universities to jointly double degrees in master degrees and bachelor degrees with other foreign universities;
5. in 2014 Parties signed an Interuniversity Cooperation Agreement in order to set up a degree programme aimed to the granting of a second cycle double degree: Laurea Magistrale in Management dell’Economia Sociale awarded by the University of Bologna and Master en Economía Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas) awarded by University of Valencia. This Agreement started from academic year 2013/2014 and it was applicable for four academic years;
6. the above mentioned Agreement has been renewed in 2017 by means of an exchange of official notes signed by Rectors of the Parties, permitting its application to four further academic years until the cohort of students enrolled in academic year 2020/2021;
7. Parties intend now to continue their collaboration signing a new text of Agreement;
8. Parties, with their resources and funds and in accordance with the law and regulations of their respective country, shall collaborate and host all students, faculty members and administrative staff who participate in the mobility programme as described in this Agreement.

It is agreed and stipulated as follows:

Art. 1 Preamble

Art. 2 Objective of the Agreement

The Parties agree to establish an integrated study programme which provides for the exchange of applicant students for a period of minimum one semester and maximum two semesters at the end of which both Universities will grant a second cycle degree: Laurea Magistrale in Management dell'Economia Sociale of University of Bologna (two years, 120 ECTS) and Máster en Economía Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas) of University of Valencia (one year, 60 ECTS).

The integrated study programme is set up taking into account that the University of Bologna complies with a 3+2 Laurea-Laurea Magistrale (L-LM) system while the University of Valencia complies with a 4+1 Grau-Máster system.

To the purposes of the present Agreement, Parties establish an integrated study programme which creates the correspondence between the last year of the four years degree and the year of Máster, on Spanish side, and the two years of Laurea Magistrale, on Italian side.

Art. 3 Students

3.1 Students Exchange

The exchange should be balanced and involve an equivalent number of students from both Universities, where possible.

Both Universities agree that the number of participating students will not be more than four units from each university per academic year. Parties shall be able to jointly agree a higher number of participants upon a notice exchange between the Parties

Students involved in the mobility programme shall also enjoy the benefits and shall be likewise subject to the regulations and norms which are in force in the Universities concerned by the programme.

Students will be selected by means of a public call in respect of equality and meritocracy principles and on the basis of students' academic career.

3.2 Exams Recognition

All exams successfully passed at the Host partner University by student shall be automatically recognized by the Home University according to correspondence tables attached to the present Agreement.

3.3 Students admission

Students participating to the present integrated study programme have to be entitled of admission requirements as determined by applicable law in each University, by provisions of the present Agreement and by the above-mentioned public call.

Both Universities agree to admit to their respective degree programme students selected by the partner University provided that the following admission requirements are met.

Students from the University of Bologna who want to attend the integrated study programme have:

- to be regularly enrolled at the degree programme Laurea Magistrale in Management dell'Economia Sociale;
- to have obtained at least 60 ECTS in the above-mentioned degree programme;
- to have an adequate knowledge of Spanish and English languages, to have regularly paid University fees and to be entitled of a valid visa or residence permit.

They will move to the University of Valencia during their third and fourth semesters of their Laurea Magistrale in order to attend teaching activities provided within the Master en Economía Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas) and to defend their final thesis, in accordance with the correspondence table annexed to the Agreement (Annex 1).

Students from the University of Valencia who want to attend the integrated study programme have:

- to own a four years degree in Economics, Management or similar areas or to own a four years degree in other areas, but having obtained at least 40 ECTS in at least two of the following disciplinary fields: management, economics, law and mathematics-statistics. The minimum grade required to verify students' preparation, required by the degree programme Laurea Magistrale in Management dell'Economia Sociale, is replaced by the admission to the Spanish Master provided by University of Valencia;
- to have obtained during the four years degree at least 44 ECTS referring to the disciplinary sectors indicated in the teaching regulations attached to the present Agreement as Annex 2. These credits have to be summed up with 40 ECTS required for the admission in case of a non-economic/non-managerial four years degree;
- to be regularly enrolled at the degree programme Master en Economía Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas);
- to have an adequate knowledge of Italian and English languages, to have regularly paid University fees and to be entitled of a valid visa or residence permit.

During their last semester of their Máster programme, students from University of Valencia will move to the University of Bologna in order to

attend teaching activities provided within Laurea Magistrale in Management dell'Economia Sociale. They will obtain 36 ECTS at the University of Bologna in accordance with the correspondence table annexed to the Agreement (Annex 2) and they will finally return to Valencia in order to defend the final thesis.

According to the study plan attached to the present Agreement all students participating in the integrated study programme will defend their final thesis at the University of Valencia.

In order to defend the final thesis, each student is assigned a tutor (professor of the Máster) who accompanies and reviews them during the development process. In addition, the tutor will sign the authorization so that the student is able to present the final thesis. The evaluation is made by a Commission made up of three professors of the Máster once the thesis has been read and defended by students in a public call. The tutor fills in a report in which he collects the assessments of it and the Commission will have access to this assessment and may or not take it into account.

The Commissions in charge of the final examination may include one professor from the University of Bologna, who must have previously participated into the integrated study programme.

3.4 Enrolment and Fees

Payment for tuition fees for public services of education must be based on criteria of reciprocity. Students participating in the integrated study programme will enroll and pay admission fees only at the Home University and they shall be exempted from paying university admission fees at the Host University where they attend their mobility period, except for administrative

fees (student card, school insurance and student file) and the degree granting fee if required.

During the mobility period students will remain enrolled in their Home university and they will be registered at the Host university.

All other charges, including health insurance, accommodation, transports and books shall be borne by the students themselves.

3.5 Certifications, Renouncements and Dropout

Host Universities agree to release and grant each mobility programme student a Transcript of Records indicating his/her attended teaching activities and his/her academic performances and number of credits (ECTS) obtained at the partner University. Home Universities agree to recognize credits earned at the Host University according to article 4 of the present Agreement. Students who are not able to continue their study path have to promptly communicate their decision to the administrative reference offices of the Host University and to the Coordinators of the programme.

3.6 Insurance obligation

The University of Bologna states that its respective regularly admitted students are insured against any accident that they may suffer during their period of stay abroad for the activities concerned by this Agreement and that they are insured for legal liability against damages which they may involuntarily cause to third party (people or their properties).

The University of Valencia states that its respective regularly admitted students younger than 28 are insured against any accident that they may suffer during their period of stay abroad for the activities concerned by this Agreement and that they are insured for legal liability against damages which they may involuntarily cause to third party (people or their properties).

Parties will inform students of the necessity to autonomously buy health care and repatriation insurances.

3.7 Services offered

Students participating into the integrated study programme shall benefit from all services offered by the host University to its regular enrolled students necessary for completing their studies.

3.8 Fellowship

Each University can grant the available fellowships to their students who intend to participate into the integrated study programme, on the basis of a proper selection procedure.

Art. 4 Didactics

4.1 Study programme

Both Universities set up and approve their study programme divided in semesters, modules and credits (ECTS). Study programme covers the entire period of study until the award of the degree qualification. Exams and study period duration shall be organized in a balanced form and shall find justification and validation in both partner Universities, according to the provisions of articles 2 and 3 and to bonds included in the attached study programme.

4.2 Amendments to the study programme

Study programme attached to the present Agreement will be applicable to students enrolled starting from academic year 2021/2022 and it can be modified by mutual consent between the Parties and exchange of official notes signed by Rectors, to no detriment of students already enrolled.

4.3 Use of ECTS and Correspondence table

The Parties agree to use the ECTS scoring system based on the grade equivalence table attached to this agreement (Annex 3).

The correspondences between teaching activities and credits are indicated in Annexes 1 and 2 to the present Agreement.

The University of Bologna will commute the grade of the final dissertation assigned by University of Valencia on the basis of the table attached to the present Agreement as Annex 3.

4.4 Award of the degree qualifications

Students participating in the integrated study programme obtain the degree qualification Master en Economia Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas) awarded by the University of Valencia according to article 3.3. They can then require the award of the degree Laurea Magistrale in Management dell'Economia Sociale by the University of Bologna on the basis of the related correspondence table annexed to this Agreement, by submitting the relevant academic documentation.

Art. 5 Use of name / Logo

Each Party may use the logos, names and other marks of the other parties only in connection with the programme. Each Party anticipates the other party's participation in press announcements, marketing and other reasonable promotional activities involving the double degree programme through the appropriate use of the logos, names and marks of the Parties.

Art. 6 Prevention and security

Both Parties shall supply each mobility programme participant with detailed information about the specific risks existing in the work environment in which they will operate and carry out their function and with necessary documentation about the prevention and emergency security measures and

provisions in force in relation to their activity and about the persons in charge of this, in compliance with the legislative norms and regulations in force in the country of the hosting University.

Art. 7 Intellectual property

Each of the Parties acknowledges and agrees that any and all of the Intellectual Property Rights or other proprietary rights in respect of any literature, materials, research or teaching methods, procedures, processes and/or the learning experience in relation to or in connection with the Programme and any parts thereof, are and shall remain the sole property of its owner and, save as expressly set out herein, nothing in this Agreement is intended to transfer ownership or create any licensed rights under any such Intellectual Property Rights or other proprietary rights.

The learning materials and any other literature, materials, research methods, procedures, processes or programmes in which a party has Intellectual Property Rights relating to or in connection with the Programme and which are disclosed to the other party pursuant to this Agreement may be used by the other party solely for the purposes of performing its obligations under, and during the period of, this Agreement and for no other purpose.

Art. 8 Data Protection

Regarding personal data transmission each Parties shall meet the requirements of the EU General Data Protection Regulation and act upon accordingly.

Each university shall be responsible for the data that it processes and for complying with the data protection regulations to which it is subject.

Art. 9 Joint Monitoring and Control Commitee

A Joint Monitoring and Control Committee shall be set up to coordinate and monitor all matters relating to the implementation of this agreement.

This committee must be made up of one representatives from each partner university that are:

- for University of Valencia: President of Master en Economía Social (Cooperativas y Entidades no Lucrativas),
- for University of Bologna: Coordinator of the degree programme Laurea Magistrale in Management dell'Economia Sociale.

The committee shall meet at the request of either party or, at least once, a year.

References offices for students participating in the double degree programme are listed in Annex 4 to this Agreement.

Art. 10 Duration of the Agreement

This Agreement will operate from the last date of signing and will be effective for a period of four years starting from academic year 2021/2022.

The last cohort of students will enroll in academic year 2023/2024 and will conclude the double degree programme in academic year 2024/2025.

This Agreement may be extended by mutual written agreement between the Parties.

The Agreement may be amended by mutual written agreement between the Parties in compliance with reference rules and regulations and with guidelines of Governing Bodies of the Parties.

This Agreement may be terminated at the request of either Party provided that a minimum of six months' prior written notice is given to the other party to enable satisfactory arrangements to be put in place for students already participating in the programme and those to whom an offer of a place on the

Programme has been formally made. Both parties shall be equally responsible for such arrangements.

Any modification or termination of the Agreement shall be carried out in such a way as to ensure no damage for the participants in the programme already underway.

If any of the partner institutions wishes to withdraw, it must be guaranteed that all the students admitted to this institution will be able to regularly complete their studies.

Annexes can be individually modified by mutual consent between the Parties by means of an exchange of notes between the partner universities, to no detriment to the students already enrolled.

Art. 11 Evaluation of the programme

The Parties will consult each other when appropriate, but at least once a year, in order to evaluate the programme development, to draw up a report about the ongoing initiatives and to elaborate other cooperation programmes.

Art. 12 Controversies

In the event of any controversy arising from this agreement the Parties will endeavour to resolve the matter amicably and in good faith.

Art. 13 Copies and language

This Agreement is digitally subscribed in one original drawn up in English language.

The Parties confirm that each and every part of this Agreement was subject of specific negotiations.

The Parties agree that it will be signed by the application of electronic signatures and exchanged between them using the following institutional e-
