

COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITAT DE VALÈNCIA AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CALABRIA, FOR THE DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMME MASTER'S DEGREE IN CONTEMPORARY PHILOSOPHICAL THOUGHT AND THE LAUREA MAGISTRALE IN SCIENZE FILOSOFICHE (LMSF)

Of the one part, the Universitat de València Estudi General (hereinafter referred to as UV), having its legal address at Avenida de Blasco Ibáñez, 13, 46010 Valencia, with fiscal identification number Q-4618001-D and represented herein by its rector, Ms María Vicenta Mestre Escrivá, acting by virtue of Article 94 of the Statutes of the Universitat de València, which were approved by Decree 128/2004, of 30 July, of the Consell de la Generalitat (DOGV 2004/8213), amended by Decree 45/2013, of 28 March, of the Consell (DOGV 2013/6994) and entitled to enter into this agreement by virtue of her appointment by Decree 41/2018, of 6 April, of the Consell (DOGV 2018/8270).

Of the other part, the University of Calabria (hereinafter referred to as UNICAL), having its legal address at via Pietro Bucci, 87036 Arcavacata di Rende, Cs, with fiscal identification number: 80003950781, and represented herein by its rector, Mr. Nicola Leone, acting by virtue of Article 2.2 of the Statutes of the University of Calabria, which were approved by Decree 562/2012, of 23th March, amended by Decree 1464/2020, of 9th October.

The parties to this agreement hereby

DECLARE

1. That the Universitat de València is a public university that, in accordance with Article 27.10 of the Spanish Constitution and with Organic Law 6/2001, of 21 December, on Universities, has its own legal personality and performs its functions independently of and in coordination with the rest of universities. Its services include providing public higher education and issuing official degree certificates that are valid throughout the national territory.
2. That the Universitat de València offers, among others, the Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought.
3. That the University of Calabria is a public university that, in accordance with Article 33.1 of the Italian Constitution and with Law 168/1989, of 9th May, on Universities, has its own legal personality and performs its functions independently of and in coordination with the rest of universities. Its services include providing public higher education and issuing official degree certificates that are valid throughout the national territory.

4. That the University of Calabria offers, among others, the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche (LMSF).

5. That both universities signed a cooperation agreement for the double degree programme Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought and the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche (LMSF), in 1th April 2016. That agreement will be extended while any partner university ask for the end.

6. But now it is necessary to modify that agreement according to the Spanish Law 40/2015, 1th October. So, both universities are interested in renewing the agreement.

The parties, acting in their aforementioned capacities, acknowledge the other's legal capacity to enter into this agreement according to the following

CLAUSES

ONE. - AIM OF THE AGREEMENT

The aim of this agreement is to implement a double degree programme between the UV and the UNICAL, by means of which the students enrolled will obtain Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought from the UV and the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche from the UNICAL.

Participation in this double degree programme is open to students enrolled in the Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought at the UV or in the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche at the UNICAL.

To this end, this agreement specifies the general requirements for participating in this double degree programme. Likewise, it establishes the number of credits and the name of the modules or subjects of the curriculum that the students must take at each of the partner universities.

TWO. - REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING THE DEGREES

Upon completion of the courses included in the double degree programme, each student may apply for the official degree certificates of the double degree programme: Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought from the UV and the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche from the UNICAL.

Both degrees are official university degrees in the country of the issuing university and are accredited by the relevant national agencies.

So, to obtain the qualification of Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought from the UV and the the qualification of Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche from the UNICAL, students must complete:

- At the UV 30 ECTS:
 - o at least 15 ECTS of the elective subjects of the Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought
 - o the compulsory subject " Seminars on research work " (3 ECTS)
 - o to defend their Master's final project in the UV (12 ECTS)
- At the UNICAL 60 ECTS:
 - o at least 45 ECTS from the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche
 - o to defend their Laurea's final project in the UNICAL (15 ECTS).

In total, between the two universities, they have to take 125 ECTS to obtain the two degrees. Details of the modules and subjects that students must take at each of the partner universities are set out in Appendix I to this agreement.

THREE. – OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

The universities that sign this agreement are responsible for:

- implementing the training courses leading to the degrees according to the corresponding curriculum;
- safekeeping the students' academic records;
- recording and issuing the corresponding degree certificate.

FOUR. – EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS

1. The universities agree to exchange a maximum of 4 new students for each university, each academic year, within the framework of the double degree programme.

2. Parity in the number of exchange students is required. This balance may be adjusted during the term of this agreement. However, in the event that there is an imbalance in the number of exchanges in an academic year, the host university receiving more students will have the final decision on how many exchange students beyond the required balance it is willing to accept during that academic year.

FIVE. – STUDENT ADMISSION

1. At all events, participation in this double degree programme requires that applicants meet the entry and admission requirements for the aforementioned university degrees according to the regulations in force at each university.

2. Both universities are committed to selecting students wishing to participate in the double degree programme according to objective and specific criteria based on equality, merit and ability.

3. The requirements for participating in the double degree programme are:

For students from the Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought at UV:

- The qualification of the Degree in Philosophy or "Licenciatura en Filosofia".
- to have passed 15 ECTS credits of the first year of Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought.
- to be able to provide proof of a B1 level of Italian.

And for students from the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche at UNICAL:

- to have passed 198 ECTS of the three years of the Laurea Triennale that let to access to the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche.
- to have passed 18 ECTS credits of the first year of the Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche when you fill out the application and to have passed 30 ECTS before to go to the UV.
- to be able to provide proof of a B1 level of Spanish.

4. Both universities agree to admit students nominated by the other university on a reciprocal basis, provided that they meet the requirements for entry and admission to the university degree in accordance with the regulations in force at each university.

5. Once the selection has been made, the home university shall send the host university a complete dossier of each exchange student including the following duly certified documents:

- a) university degree that gives access to the Master's Degree in Contemporary Philosophical Thought at UV or Laurea Magistrale in Scienze Filosofiche at UNICAL.
- b) certificate of the subjects successfully completed in the degree under this programme;
- c) copy of ID or passport.

This dossier must reach the host institution no later than two months before the start of the semester when the mobility period is expected.

6. After verifying compliance with entry and admission requirements, the host university shall go through all the formalities needed to complete the enrolment.

SIX. – RECOGNITION OF SUBJECTS

Both universities shall recognise the subjects passed and the competences acquired during the periods of study in the home and host institutions within the framework of the qualifications referred to in clause seven.

SEVEN. – TABLE OF EQUIVALENCE

The parties agree on a table of equivalence of the marking and assessment systems of each institution, which is attached to this agreement as Appendix II. Any modification to this table must be validated by the person responsible for the programme at each institution.

EIGHT. – PROMOTION OF STUDIES

1. Each institution shall include a description of the double degree programme under this agreement, including entry requirements, on its website.
2. Each party may use the name of the other party to promote the studies covered by this agreement.

NINE. - FEES

1. Payment of tuition fees for public services must be based on criteria of reciprocity. Exchange students will pay tuition fees at the home university and not at the host university. Therefore, students will be exempt from payment at the host institution except for administrative fees such as the issuance of the university card, school insurance and academic record management, which are to be paid by exchange students.
2. Travel expenses, accommodation, meals, teaching materials and other personal expenses must be borne by participants themselves.
3. Each student is responsible for their visa application and associated costs. If the student requires a confirmation of enrolment or a letter of invitation from the host university to obtain a visa or scholarship, these must be sent as soon as possible.
4. Each exchange student is required to obtain health care and repatriation insurance. The student is responsible for the costs of such insurance.
5. In the event that a student has to retake a failed subject or module of those studied at the host university, they must pay the second registration fee at the host university.

6. Students who complete the double degree programme regulated herein must pay the fees for issuing the degree certificates at both universities.

TEN. - EXCHANGE STUDENT SERVICE

1. Exchange students are entitled to use the services of the host university necessary for completing their studies.
2. Universities must establish ways of welcoming exchange students, supporting them in finding accommodation and, if necessary, providing them with the documents required to process entry visas.
3. Both universities agree to communicate emergency situations involving their respective exchange students.

ELEVEN. – JOINT MONITORING AND CONTROL COMMITTEE

1. A Joint Monitoring and Control Committee shall be set up to coordinate and monitor all matters relating to the implementation of this agreement.

This committee must be made up of two representatives from each partner university. The members of this committee are included in Appendix III to this agreement.

The committee shall meet at the request of either party or, at least once, a year.

TWELVE. - ACADEMIC AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

1. Exchange students are subject to the academic and disciplinary regulations of the host university during their stay.
2. Each university reserves the right to expel an exchange student if his/her conduct or work violates the academic or disciplinary regulations of that university. In all events, the host university must immediately inform the home university of this circumstance and the student may be expelled after the corresponding disciplinary inquiry has been examined.

THIRTEEN. - TERM

1. This agreement shall enter into force on the date of the last signature and shall remain in effect throughout four academic years including the years 2020-2021, 2021-2022, 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.

2. This agreement may be extended once more, for an equal period, by written agreement between both universities, prior to the date of its termination.

FOURTEEN. - EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION AND DATA PROTECTION

1. Collaboration between the signatory parties involves the transfer and processing of personal data, so the parties commit themselves to complying with current legislation on data protection in Italy and in Spain, and to taking all relevant measures for such protection to be real and effective.

2. Each university shall be responsible for the data that it processes and for complying with the data protection regulations to which it is subject.

FIFTEEN. – RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The universities participating in this double degree programme act as independent legal entities so that each is responsible for the corresponding obligations towards its own staff.

2. This agreement is not exclusive, so each of the universities is free to establish double degree programmes with other universities.

SEVENTEEN. - AMENDMENTS

This agreement may be amended, before the expiry of its period of validity, by express mutual agreement, and any amendments shall be added as an addendum hereto.


EIGHTEEN. - CAUSES FOR TERMINATION

This agreement may be terminated for any of the following reasons:

- a) For expiration of its validity.
- b) By mutual consent of the parties.
- c) At the instigation of one of the parties, by giving the other party no less than twelve months' express notice.

Early termination of this agreement for whatever reason shall not negatively affect the students that have started the course. Consequently, no student that has begun the double degree programme will be deprived of the opportunity to complete the programme, provided that completion is not delayed for more than three years from the start of the programme.

The parties hereto sign two equally valid counterparts of this agreement.
