

Cecilio Tamarit is currently Professor of Economics at the University of Valencia. He holds an endowed “ad personam” Jean Monnet Chair in Economic Integration from the European Commission and is a research affiliate of the INTECO UV-UJI joint research unit. He was previously Senior Fellow at the Wharton School (University of Pennsylvania), Senior Advisor at the Spanish Prime Minister’s Economic Office, invited professor at the University of Nottingham, and visiting scholar at Goettingen and Harvard. He was also a “Robert Schuman Scholar” at the Research Directorate of the European Parliament (Luxembourg). His main lines of research are Monetary and Fiscal Integration, International Trade and Macroeconometrics. He has published extensively in academic journals as Oxford Bulletin of Economics and Statistics, Journal of Banking and Finance, Economic Inquiry, Journal of Economic Behavior and Organization, Journal of Comparative Economics, Economics Letters, Journal of Macroeconomics or Economic Modelling. He currently serves as advisory editor in Environmental Modeling and Assessment. He earned a MA in European Economics from the College of Europe (Bruges, Belgium) and a Ph D. (with honors) from the University of Valencia. He has been a consultant to the Spanish Ministry of Economy and the European Commission, member of the WES group of experts of the CESifo and the Euro Area Business Cycle Network. From 1998 to 2003, he has been President of the Spanish Association of International Economics and Finance (AEEFI-IEFS) and between 2006 and 2009, he has been President of the Advisory Economy Committee in the National Commission for the Evaluation of Research Activity (CNEAI). From 2006 to 2014, he served successively as Vice-President and President of the Asociación Libre de Economía (ALdE), where he is an honorary fellow.
