

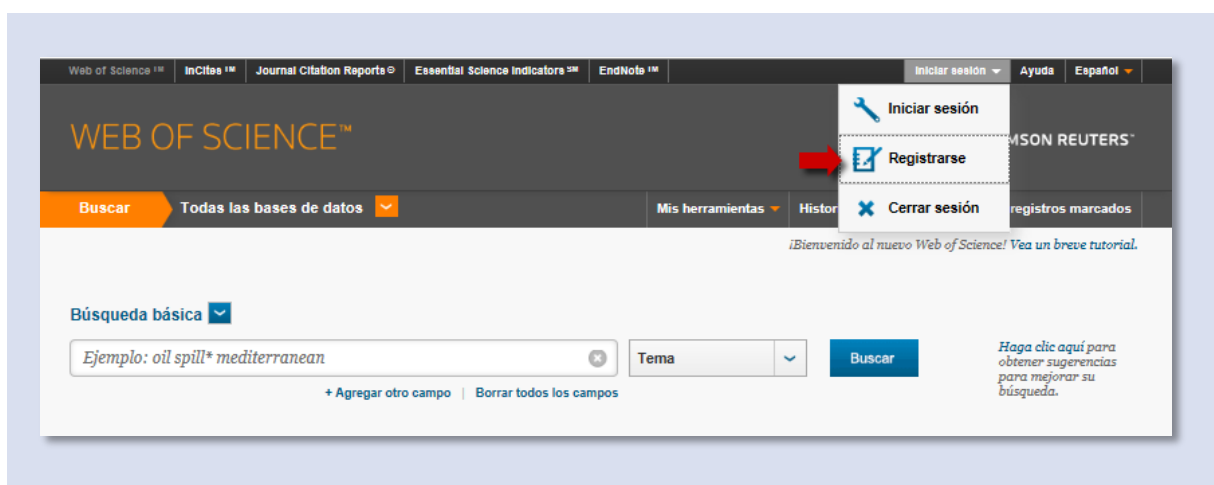
## CREA UN PERFIL EN RESEARCHER-ID

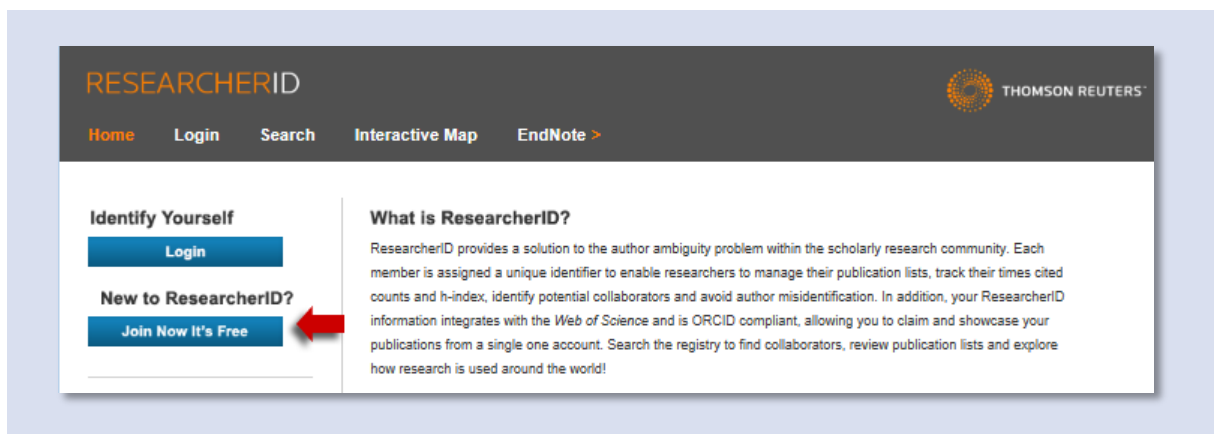
Para acceder tienes que estar en un ordenador de la Universitat de València o [conectarte a ella mediante VPN](#)

### ENTRADA Y REGISTRO

- Si ya estás registrado en Web of Science (WoS) o en EndNote, es conveniente usar el mismo nombre de usuario y contraseña para simplificar sus procesos de autenticación.
- Pasos a seguir para crear un perfil o cuenta en ResearcherID:
  - Desde WoS: Entra en la Web of Science: [http://trobes.uv.es/record=b1783232~S1\\*val](http://trobes.uv.es/record=b1783232~S1*val) o directamente en <http://wos.fecyt.es>. Pulsar en *Iniciar sesión* la opción **Registrarse**



- O desde el portal de [ResearcherID](http://www.researcherid.com) pulsar **Join now, it's free**. Directamente en <http://www.researcherid.com/Home.action?SID=S2YkvEsGk5JXn22x7KO&returnCode=ROUTER.Success&SrcApp=CR&Init=Yes>

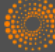

#### ASOCIAR LA BIBLIOGRAFIA

- Para asociar la bibliografía debemos hacer una búsqueda por autor de nuestros artículos y una vez los reconocemos irlos marcando
- No olvidar tener en cuenta las variedades posible con la que firmamos. Por ejemplo para un autor llamado José Luis Pérez Villanueva
  - Apellido Apellido, Inicial → Perez Villanueva, JL
  - Apellido-Apellido, Inicial → Perez-Villanueva, JL
  - 2º Apellido, Iniciales (La primera de nuestro nombre y la segunda de la primera letra de nuestro primer apellido) → Villanueva, JLP (ya que en el ámbito anglosajón no hay 2º)
  - Etc
- Otra opción es buscar por el título del artículo
