Since 1993 until 1998 I worked in a Trade Union Comisiones Obreras (CCOO), as an expert in training and culture. CCOO is the Spanish trade union with more representative workers.

Since 1996 I'm teaching in Sociology and Social Anthropology Departament of Valence University (since 2002 as a civil servant).

Since 1984 I work with a Philosophy teachers team, the Grup Embolic (Muddle Team). We are published a lot of books about Philosophy, Didactics of Philosophy, and Movies and Philosophy.
