HANDOUT 19.5: CHECKLIST FOR HOUSEHOLD POISONS

Tips to prevent accidental poisoning:

- avoid use of poisonous materials
- store poisons and caustic substances on high shelves
- read instructions with care
- label poisons carefully
- cap containers securely
- dispose of poisons safely as directed
- keep updated poison treatment charts
- keep antidotes accessible
 - keep numbers of poison control centres handy
- do not mix chemicals

store poisons in childproof containers with tamperproof lids and internal seals
