HANDOUT 7.9: INDICATIONS FOR A PROFESSIONAL OPINION: SKIN LESIONS

FINDINGS THAT NEED A PROFESSIONAL OPINION	
	a change in the colour, shape or size of a skin blemish a flat or raised area of skin with a mild intermittent itch an area of skin that bleeds spontaneous or on touching a smooth pinkish pearly lump a persistent rough patch in a sun-exposed area
FINDINGS THAT NEED URGENT ATTENTION	
	asymmetrical lesions lesions with an irregular border. Abrupt breakdown of pigment at the edge of the
	lesion and radial streaming beyond the border of the lesion are ominous signs lesions of more than 5 mm diameter
	lesions with a variable colour. Black dots in the periphery of the lesion suggest malignancy
	flesh-coloured, red or pink nodules which enlarge, ulcerate and crust
