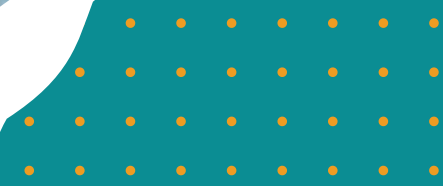

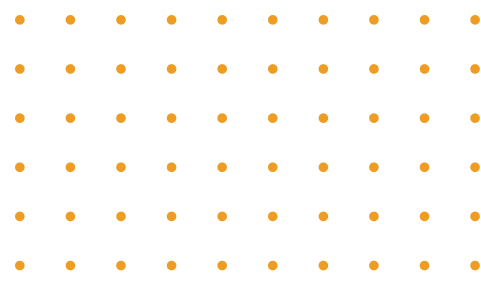


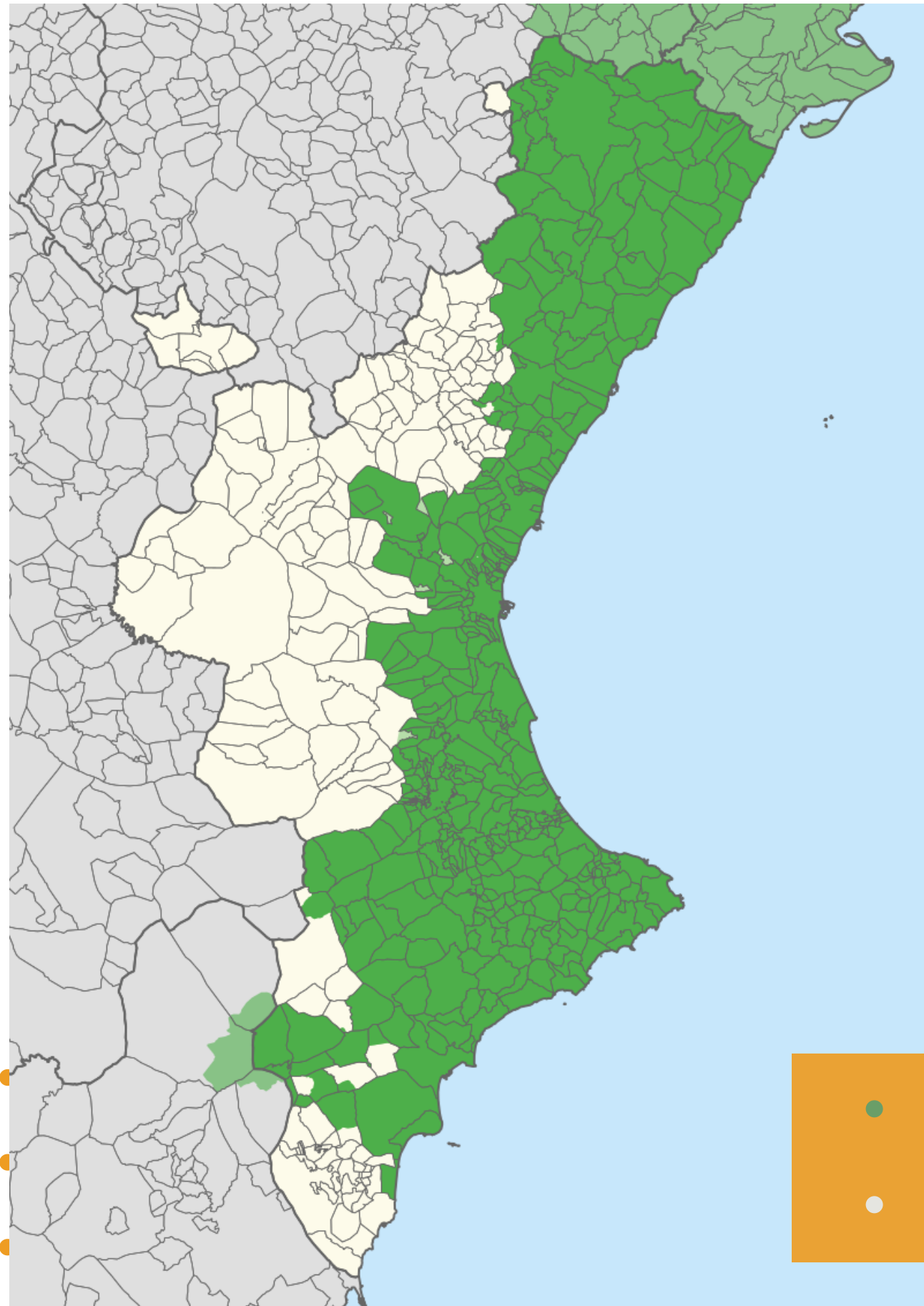


Welcome to **VALENCIA**

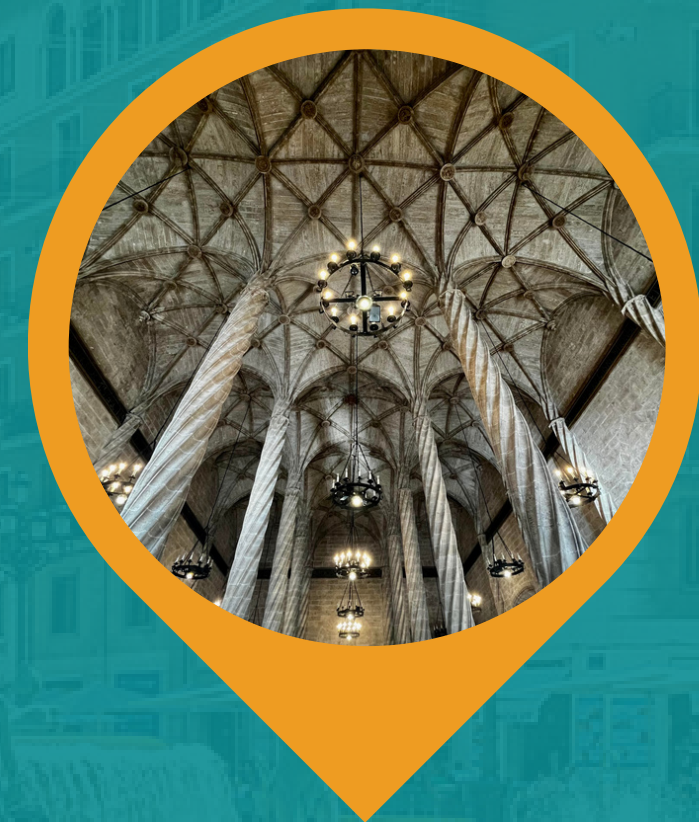

FALLAS DE VALÈNCIA



The festivity has been declared Intangible Heritage of Humanity by Unesco.



It runs from 14th to 19th March and officially begins on the last Sunday in February with the act of the *crida*.



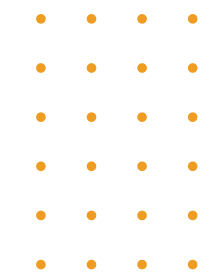
During the Fallas week, large satirical sculptural groups called "fallas" are displayed in the streets of the city, along with deafening firework displays or *mascletás*, as well as firecrackers, concerts, music bands, parades of falleras, fireworks and floral offerings to the Virgin.

Getting around METROVALENCIA

- Metrovalencia offers 9 lines that can be combined to reach any point in the city.
- From 4 am to 11.30 pm on weekdays; from 5 am to midnight on weekends.
- Fare from the airport: approximately €5.

If you come by plane, the closest stop to the FFTiC is "Facultats". If you come by train, you will have to take the stop "Xàtiva", near the North Station.

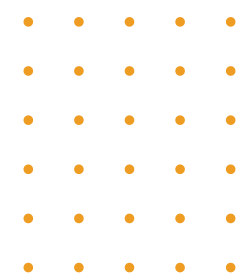


Getting around **AUTOBUSES**

- Valencia has a very complete and frequent network of city buses (EMT) and suburban buses (Metrobus).
- From 4 am to 10.30 pm. The night service ends at 2 a.m. on weekdays and at 3.30 a.m. on weekends.
- Ticket: 1,50€ each way.

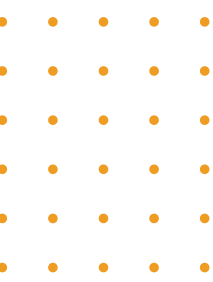
Download the EMT app, valid for iOS and Android. It lets you know when the bus arrives at a stop, calculate routes and save favourites.



Getting around **VALENBISI**



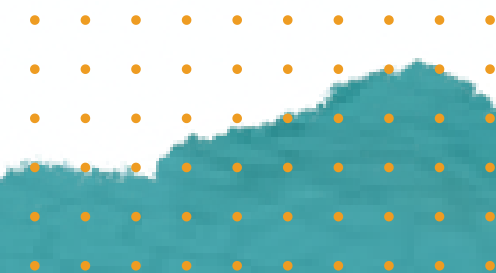
- Valenbisi is a public bicycle rental service located in the city of Valencia.
- Available 24/7.
- Rent your Valenbisi: identify yourself, select the type of subscription and choose your Valenbisi (the first 30 minutes are free).
- Return your Valenbisi at one of the stations.
