Programme dropout

- 1. In the event that a UV student does not pass the subjects of one or more semesters, either in the home or host university, according to their corresponding regulations, he/she will be considered to have failed the examinations leading to the double degree.
- 2. In these cases, students will be offered solutions including, but not limited to, the possibility of a second enrolment, for a full year or for a semester, or the possibility of dropping out of the DDP to return to the starting programmes (MTCH-UV or T2M-UB). The local academic coordinators will meet to agree on the most appropriate solution according to the regulations in force.
- 3. In the event of dropping out or being excluded from the programme, the student will keep the subjects passed, including those validated, in their academic record for the TMI-UV and/or the MTCH-UV. In the event that the UV student has not completed a semester at the UB, partial validation of the subjects passed may be carried out upon request.
- 4. The two-year programme allows for an additional year of enrolment to obtain the double degree.
