

Programme dropout

1. In the event that a UV student does not pass the subjects of one or more semesters, either in the home or host university, according to their corresponding regulations, he/she will be considered to have failed the examinations leading to the double degree.
2. In these cases, students will be offered solutions including, but not limited to, the possibility of a second enrolment, for a full year or for a semester, or the possibility of dropping out of the DDP to return to the starting programmes (MTCH-UV or T2M-UB). The local academic coordinators will meet to agree on the most appropriate solution according to the regulations in force.
3. In the event of dropping out or being excluded from the programme, the student will keep the subjects passed, including those validated, in their academic record for the TMI-UV and/or the MTCH-UV. In the event that the UV student has not completed a semester at the UB, partial validation of the subjects passed may be carried out upon request.
4. The two-year programme allows for an additional year of enrolment to obtain the double degree.
