Entrance and selection tests

Candidates applying to the programme will be selected as follows:

- 1. They must complete a translation exercise and an interview in French, English and/or Spanish with the local Academic Coordinator of the programme and, if applicable, with the Academic Coordinator at the partner university.
- 2. Once the exercise and the interview have been graded, the results will be ranked according to the following weightings: 50% for the consolidated academic record in TMI-UV, 25% for the translation exercise and 25% for the interview.
- 3. Applicants must pass both the translation exercise and the interview.
- 4. The two students with the highest scores in each pathway (Language B: French and Language C: English, or Language B: English and Language C: French) will be selected. If the two places in one of the two pathways are not filled, the remaining available places will be assigned to the other pathway, respecting the established order of priority.
- 5. A pre-selection will be made during the UV Erasmus grant award period. The final selection will be made when the pre-selected students have successfully completed at least 180 ECTS credits of TMI-UV, including all core and compulsory subjects of the first three years of the degree.

Grants

Participation in the programme is compatible with the Erasmus grants for undergraduate studies. Grants must be applied for within the period and in the manner established by the UV International Relations Service.

Students who have been awarded an Erasmus study grant are not exempt from passing the tests established for admission to the programme, nor is the grant a condition for participating in the programme.
