

LOCKER LENDING SERVICE AT BIBLIOTECA D'EDUCACIO MARIA MOLINER

1. What is this service?

Individual loan service of the University of Valencia's Education Library's BOOTHS in order to make it easier for users to deposit their personal objects for greater convenience in the use of the Library's services.

2. Who can use it?

This service can be used by the entire university community (students, teaching and research staff and administrative and service staff) and users who are in possession of a UV card.

The padlock can be borrowed at the lending desk. If any user is blocked by the system for any reason (expiry of his or her registration, books pending return, etc.), he or she will not be able to use this service.

3. Procedure

The lockers are locked by means of a padlock provided at our counter. The padlock is given with the combination 000. The user changes it on the spot for secure use and returns it with 000. Follow the instructions included in the padlock bag.

4. Conditions and characteristics of the loan

The padlock will be loaned during the day and must be returned before the loan desk closes at 8.30 pm.

5. User responsibilities and sanctions

The user is responsible for the proper use of the equipment during the loan period. The request for a locker implies the correct use of the locker. If the user forgets the combination lock and the locker cannot be opened, he/she must buy a new one of the same model.

It is forbidden to bring food into the lockers. Dangerous substances or substances that are a nuisance to other users are not allowed in the lockers. All electrical appliances must be switched off or switched to silent mode.

The library may open lockers that have not been released in order to empty them. It may also check their contents, in the presence or absence of the user, when there are reasons that make such a check advisable.

Deterioration due to misuse will be repaired at the user's expense.

The instructions of library staff must be followed at all times.

Any person who does not comply with the rules may lose the right to use them.

The Library is not responsible for any damage, loss, theft, etc. of materials deposited in the lockers.
