

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING YOUR CREDENTIALS

As a previous step to applying for admission to UV Doctoral Programs, IT IS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN YOUR CREDENTIALS (username and password), for this purpose you must follow the link:

➤ **STEP 1 OF 4: Authorisation to use contact details**

You authorise the use and storage of your data, click on **I authorise**

Step 1 of 4: Authorisation to use contact details

You have accessed this screen to obtain the credentials (username and password) with which you can request admission to a course offered by the University of Valencia.

The credentials you will obtain in this process will allow you to apply for admission and, if you are finally admitted, use them to entol and access the rest of the services related to your enrolment.

To do so, you must authorise us to use and store the e-mail address you provided in your application for admission.

This data will be used to confirm your identity and will be stored by us so that you can access and manage your password in the future, in case of loss, change or use of the two-factor authentication access to the services.


