Finance and Accounting students from the Facultat d'Economia, who are interested in obtaining exemptions from the **Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA)** will need to enrol in the subjects listed in the table below.

The first four modules are awarded automatically as a Graduate of the Finance and Accounting degree at the Universitat de València.

The following four modules will be obtained by enrolling in and completing the subjects in the table.

To achieve the diploma it is therefore necessary that, in your **fourth year**, you enrol in the **5 optional subjects** listed below, instead of 4 which is the minimum in order to obtain a degree in Finance and Accounting.
