

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE MOBILITY PERIOD

(OUTGOING STUDENTS OF THE FACULTY OF ECONOMICS)

Despite the general rule proposed by the Vice Chancellor of the University of Valencia, in the Faculty of Economics, due to the high volume of exchange mobility students, the current instruction has been the non-acceptance of mobility period extension for FdE students, regardless the degree they are studying.

Notwithstanding, and considering the adverse circumstances of the past years, the International Office has considered that from the academic year 2021-2022 it will be possible to accept the extension of a semester mobility if the following conditions:

1. The student must be enrolled in a degree program which allows an exchange longer than one semester and hasn't applied for a longer stay.
2. The host university must expressly agree to accept the mobility extension of the student.
3. The student must know and understand that during the extension no grant or scholarship will be given.
4. There must be vacancies available in the host university during the requested extension period, according to the agreement between both institutions.
5. There can't be an aggregated imbalance with the host university.

Once the student has requested the extension of its mobility period, the mobility coordinator should consider the above-mentioned conditions and answer back the student's request about the acceptance or denial of it.

If the extension has been authorized, the student is responsible of the following:

1. Notify the mobility extension to the International Relations Central Services to change the student's status in the UV mobility platform.
2. Modify the LA with the coordinator's agreement.
3. Notify the mobility extension to the secretary of the Faculty of Economics in order to delete de enrolled subjects for the second semester and increase the international credits.
4. Inform the ORI too.
