

VACANCIES IN THE INTERNATIONAL DOUBLE DEGREE IN BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

A new assignment system has been implemented for Double Degrees (DD) in order to promote the International Double Degree in Business Management and Administration within the Erasmus+ area, specifically between Nantes University in France, Brescia in Italy and Jade in Germany, for students who are willing to study two years abroad:

1. Students who are interested and want to apply for one of the four proposed destinations must send an email to the coordinator noemi.herranz@uv.es before the auction period.
2. Those vacancies will be blocked in order to prioritize students who choose de IDD in BMA.
3. Previously to the nomination and the auction period, Business-Management coordinators will verify that the interested students meet the language requirement of the host university (published in *Lanzadera*).
4. Before the auction starts, coordinator will publicly mention the students interested in double degrees.
5. Coordinator will then ask if there are some other interested students. If someone speaks out, vacancies will be assigned between them according to the choice order. If the request of vacancies exceeds the offer, students may choose another destination when their turn comes.
6. If the demand of DD is less or the same as the vacancies offered, the public assignment will take place at the start of the auction. Once accepted a destination, students may leave the auction assembly.
7. For DD in Brescia (Italy), coordinators will kindly remind students that they need an English B2 certificate as a requirement to study the double degree.
8. From that moment, students can't resign from the destination chosen for the DD. If they do, they'll have to wait until the end of the auction to pick up another destination from the ones left.
9. Non-blocked DD vacancies may be offered as an annual mobility programme and can be chosen normally during the auction.
