




























The 19th Physics and Technology Experiments and Demonstrations Fair-Contest 2024 is a celebration of science and popularisation where you can see surprising phenomena. The aim is to bring science closer to the public and, at the same time, to show young people's roles in it. Different groups of secondary school students have carried out more than 70 experimental STEM projects with the help of their teachers and they exhibit and explain them at a fair open to the public, carrying out a scientific dissemination task too. 21 April 2024, Science Museum of Valencia (Calle Mayor - 1st floor). Coherence, good functioning of the project and clarity of explanations will be the most valued aspects (more details here).

The public will be able to vote for their favourite projects from 10 to 12:45 h. The project most voted project will receive the public prize. In the *Fisicalandia* workshop, children will enjoy themselves assembling simple physics demonstrations (*).

13:30-14:30- PRIZE AWARD CLOSING CEREMONY in the "Santiago Grisolía" Auditorium of the Science Museum.
