1. INTRODUCTION

Escena Erasmus is a pioneering European theatre project promoting European citizenship, aimed at both local and international Erasmus students. It is based on theatrical training and the production of original performances that offer a constant critical reflection on Europe and our way of being European. The project aims to leverage the potential of the Erasmus+ program to promote high-quality intercultural creation.

Escena Erasmus is a project of the University of Valencia, promoted by the Vice-Rectorate for Culture and Society and the Vice-Rectorate for Internationalization and Multilingualism, with the support of the General Foundation of the University of Valencia.

2. TECHNICAL INFORMATION, DURATION, AND CREDITS

2.1. COURSE INFORMATION

Escena Erasmus aims to establish itself as a productive space for cultural and linguistic exchange, offering the following activities:

- Intensive actor training course with theatrical practice. Recognized with 2 ECTS credits.
- Creation, production, and exhibition of a large-format show that, after its premiere, tours many municipalities in the Land of Valencia. Recognized with 2 ECTS credits.
- Occasional artistic activities in collaboration with various public and private Valencian, Spanish and European institutions.
- Occasional cultural exchanges through our international network, Erasmus Europe on Scene Network.

2.2. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Only students enrolled at the University of Valencia and Incoming Erasmus+ students who will be staying during the 2026-2027 academic year at the UV can participate. The approximate participation ratio in the selection of students will be: 70% Erasmus+ students and 30% University of Valencia students. Selection tests for candidates will be conducted before the course begins.

2.3. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Selected individuals must attend the course classes. Unjustified absence from more than three classes will result in the student being dropped and replaced by another candidate from the waiting list.

Selected individuals must also commit, through the official voluntary participation forms ([DOC 1](#), [DOC 2](#) & [DOC 3](#)) of the General Foundation of the University of Valencia, to

attending rehearsals and participating in all theatrical performances and sociocultural mediation activities planned by the organization.

2.4. PLANNED SCHEDULE

The Escena Erasmus project starts on October 28, 2026, and ends on July 7, 2027. These dates are approximate. Final dates will be communicated at the beginning of the course through an official activity calendar, which will also be published on the project's website.

2.5. CREDIT RECOGNITION

The Escena Erasmus project is recognized with a total of 4 ECTS credits as specified in point 2.1 for participants who meet the minimum participation requirements established in point 2.3.

3. PLACES

There are 20 places available for the 2026-2027 academic year. The minimum number of students is 10.

4. FREE TRAINING ACTIVITY

Participation in Escena Erasmus is free of charge.

5. SPECIFIC SUPPORT NEEDS

In order to guarantee the well-being, safety, and full participation in the Escena Erasmus project under equal conditions, participants are urged to communicate, at the time of registration, any specific support needs (whether physical, intellectual, sensory, mental health, allergic, or of any other nature) that require adapted attention or additional support resources.

In the event of having a specific need, it must be communicated through the form provided for this purpose. This communication is essential so that the center, in coordination with the University's disability/inclusion support services, can plan and organize the reasonable adjustments and the necessary material and human support.

Failure to communicate or submit the required documentation within the established deadlines could hinder or prevent the correct planning, implementation, and availability of these supports before the start of the activity. This could condition participation in those project dynamics where a safe and accessible environment cannot be guaranteed for the individual or the group.

All information provided will be treated with strict confidentiality, in accordance with current regulations on personal data protection.

6. PRE-REGISTRATION, EVALUATION COMMISSION, REGISTRATION, AND CERTIFICATES

6.1. PRE-REGISTRATION

Those interested in attending the selection tests to join the Escena Erasmus group 2026-2027 can pre-register from June 1, 2026, to October 12, 2026, via the Google Form available on the Escena Erasmus website (www.uv.es/escenaerasmus > Registration) at the following link: [REGISTRATION FORM ESCENA ERASMUS 2026-2027](#).

After the registration period closes, registered individuals will be contacted via email to invite them to the selection tests.

6.2. ATTENDANCE RULES FOR THE AUDITION PROCESS

Once the pre-selection of students for the acting training course of the Escena Erasmus European theatre project has been completed, registered applicants will be called to the audition process. The auditions are expected to take place on October 21st at the Performing Arts Room, located on the ground floor of the Fundació General de la Universitat de València building (4 Amadeu de Savoia Street, 46010). The audition consists of the following parts:

The test consists of the following parts:

1. Individual presentation: name, age, nationality, motivation for joining the workshop.
2. Body expression and coordination: a brief series of group exercises proposed by the evaluation committee.
3. Individual reading of a dramatic text: individual reading or dramatization of a fragment from Shakespeare's King Lear. Participants can choose between a fragment of the character Lear or Cordelia. These texts are attached in the invitation email in Valencian-Catalan, Spanish, English, French, Italian, German, and Polish. Participants can choose to read it in any of these languages or translate it into other languages not provided in the document. We will evaluate text comprehension and expressiveness.
4. Group discussion: a brief discussion to assess interest and knowledge about theater.

Participants in the selection tests are advised to prepare the text and not merely read it flatly. Scenic proposals will be especially valued.

Attendance to these selection tests must be confirmed by email to escena.erasmus@uv.es.

If any participant cannot attend the tests, they must notify the same email.

6.3 RIGHT OF ADMISSION

The right of admission will be exercised when those wishing to enter or remain in the Escena Erasmus UV activities display violent or aggressive attitudes, or behaviors that incite violence, xenophobia, or any kind of confrontation or altercation, or pose a danger or cause discomfort to other attendees.

6.4. EVALUATION COMMISSION

The evaluation of applications will be carried out by a committee composed of the Escena Erasmus UV team from the General Foundation of the University of Valencia. Escena Erasmus UV may invite individuals who, due to their professional trajectory and knowledge of the project, can add value to the selection tests for the new group.

The committee will evaluate applications based on the following criteria:

- Individual presentation
- Physical test and group play
- Dramatized reading or dramatization of the proposed text
- Other quality factors to consider (artistic training, theatrical experience, languages, etc.).

6.5. FORMAL REGISTRATION

Once the selection results are communicated via email to the successful candidates, it is necessary to register for Escena Erasmus through the General Foundation of the University of Valencia's course application at the following link: <https://cursos.fundacio.es/>. The direct link to the course will be provided in the email to the selected new participants.

6.6. COMMITMENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN ESCENA ERASMUS

- Attend all classes of the actor training course during the academic year.
- Be part of the group of actors and actresses, attend necessary rehearsals, perform in all scheduled shows, and organize and participate in the complementary sociocultural animation activities planned in the tour program.
- Participate in the project altruistically and voluntarily, without receiving any salary, fees, bonuses, grants, or any other remuneration. Therefore, it cannot be considered a labour, official, commercial, or any other remunerated relationship.

6.7. CERTIFICATES

To receive the participation certificate in the Escena Erasmus project, a minimum attendance of 85% of the training classes and rehearsals, as well as attendance on the tour, is required.

7. WAITING LIST

After the selection tests, the evaluation committee will create a numbered waiting list. If any places become available, they will be offered to individuals on the waiting list in numerical order.

If a person on the waiting list is contacted, they will receive an email with a link to access the course application. The interested individual must complete the registration following the usual procedure.

All this within the framework of the Escena Erasmus theatrical performances carried out during the 2026-2027 academic year, during the theatrical production, and on the exhibition tours.

This license allows others to download the works and share them with others as long as credit is given, but they cannot be altered in any way or used commercially.
