




Raise your hand to ask questions. Please use this tool only during question time.


What happens if we click on the arrow?




You can look for someone, for example an organizer.

Moderators, presenters and participants. By default, you are a participant.




If the chair of the plenary session or workshop gives you permission to connect the audio and video, you will see the following:



Now, you can share your audio and video!!


### Parallel and Poster sessions
