What should you know?

- Basic laboratory rules
 - You are going to work in a research center where you will have access to equipment and facilities of which you must know the operation and their rules of use, especially if you are going to work in a Biosafety room, Phytotron Chambers or Insect Chambers.
- Use of common facilities
 - The person in charge of your laboratory will show you the common facilities. A list of I2SysBio's general use equipment is available for users.
- Emergency Plan
 - I2SysBio has an Emergency Plan that you should be aware of. A member of your plant's emergency team will explain the measures to be taken in case of emergency. Training sessions are held periodically, which should be attended.
- Scientific Seminars & outreach
 - I2Sysbio organizes scientific seminars in the seminar room and other outreach and training activities, get involved!

I2SysBio is a joint institute of the Spanish National Research Council (CSIC) and the University of Valencia (UV), so part of the staff is employed by CSIC and part by UV.

For I2SysBio staff employed by CSIC:

On your first day at I2SysBio, please contact with <u>Elena Navarro</u> and Institute Manager <u>Ana Belén</u> for an initial orientation to your position. Basic issues: your contract, your salary, work schedule, working hours and location of your position. More initial issues: access card, e-mail account, CSIC intranet password and work equipment (computer, etc.). How to take vacation days and/or special leave, using the CSIC intranet. Attachment to your research group at I2SysBio.

On your first day at I2SysBio, please contact <u>Elena Navarro</u> and Institute Manager <u>Ana Belén</u> for an initial orientation to your position. After signing your contract, you will contact Elena Navarro again to formalize your attachment to I2SysBio and your research group within the institute.
