Response Invalidity in Survey Research: Causes, Detection, and Remedies:

Response invalidity occurs when scores collected from respondents do not reflect their actual standing on the construct of interest. The methodological literature on the causes, detection, and remedies for response invalidity has grown considerably in recent years. This presentation summarizes and evaluates this literature and provides recommendations for dealing with response invalidity.
