We open the publication of a series of short letters from the second-year students, who tell us about their internship experience. Today Natalie McCullough writes to us, from Genève, in Switzerland.

Natalie McCullough

I am Natalie McCullough, a second year student in the WOP-P Programme. I am from Indianapolis in the United States. For my internship, I am working with the International Labour Organization (ILO) in Geneva, Switzerland in the Human Resources Development department as part of the Internship Team. In this position, I am responsible for assisting in the selection and onboarding processes of new interns at the organization.

This includes working in the online recruitment system, facilitating visa procedures for international interns, working directly with department supervisors, and welcoming interns on their first day with briefing presentations. My tasks differ day by day. One day, I will be attending a conference on HR strategy and the next, I will be in a meeting to discuss how selection can foster diversity and support inclusion. As an agency of the UN, many of the conversations at the ILO surround the topic of human rights and decent work. I find this environment to be inspiring and I love conversing with people from across the




world on topics that are extremely important.

I have found my work at the ILO to be challenging, but well-suited to the skills and knowledge I gained in the WOP-P Programme. I am very grateful for this opportunity and know it would not have been possible without my experience in the WOP-P Master's.

The Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Work, Organization, and Personnel Psychology (WOP-P) receives more than 250 applications from 67 countries around the world (Europe, Latin America, USA, Asia, Africa, Canada, etc.) for the scholarships of the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union. In September 2018, the 12th edition of this Master will begin and the evaluation of candidates and selection of students has already begun. It is planned to have about 17 scholarships from the European Union for this edition, some of them specifically aimed at students from developing countries.

5. Universidad: Mavi Mestre, elegida rectora de la Universidad de Valencia



Mavi Mestre se ha convertido en la primera mujer rectora en la historia de la Universitat de València. En la segunda vuelta de las elecciones, celebrada este martes (6 de marzo), Mavi Mestre ha obtenido un 52,98% del voto ponderado, mientras Vicent J. Martínez ha conseguido un 47,02%.

Los resultados son provisionales. La Junta Electoral proclamará los resultados definitivos el próximo lunes 12 de marzo.

Entre el PDI doctores/as con vinculación permanente, Mavi Mestre ha ganado con un 27,58% de los votos ponderados. Vicent J. Martínez ha obtenido un 23,42%. En el colegio de los no doctores/as o sin vinculación permanente, Mestre ha sacado un 6,94%, y Martínez, un 5,72%. Entre los miembros

del personal de investigación en formación, el resultado ha sido: 0,80% para Vicent J. Martínez, y 0,53% para Mavi Mestre.

El estudiantado ha votado a Mavi Mestre en un 13,46% de voto ponderado, y a Vicent J. Martínez en un 11,54%. Finalmente, entre el PAS ha ganado Vicent J. Martínez con un 5,54%, mientras Mavi Mestre ha cosechado un 4,46%.

Un total de 55.254 personas estaban convocadas a las urnas. Entre el PDI doctores/as con vinculación permanente (2.010 personas) ha votado un 84,94% del censo. De los no doctores/as o sin vinculación permanente (2.750) ha acudido a las urnas un 38,19%. Entre los 437 miembros del personal de investigación en formación ha votado un 37,21%. El estudiantado de grado y posgrado (47.907) ha registrado una participación del 8,75%. Y entre el PAS (2.150), ha votado un 65,25%.

6. Universidad: María Dolores Sancerni, reelegida como decana de la Facultad de Psicología de la Universitat de València

La actual decana de la Facultad de Psicología de la Universitat de València, María Dolores Sancerni, continuará tres años más en el cargo, al haber sido reelegida este jueves (1 de marzo). Sancerni era la única candidata y ha obtenido 44 votos a favor y dos en blanco.

María Dolores Sancerni Beitia es profesora de la Facultad de Psicología de la Universitat de València desde 1987. Ha sido directora del Departamento de Metodología de las Ciencias del Comportamiento desde 2003 a 2011, miembro del Claustro desde 2009 y de la Junta de Centro desde 2002.
