The TWH approach seeks to improve well-being in the American workforce for the benefit of workers, employers, and the nation by protecting safety and enhancing health and productivity.

2. Recursos: Webcast Collaborate In The Move Towards Open Science





5. Participaciones: APA International Reception at ICAP

El prof. José María Peiró participó en la recepción internacional de la APA en el congreso ICAP que se celebró el día 26 de junio en Montreal, Canadá:

The APA International Reception's professional networking activity gathered together high-level leaders in the field from 25 countries around the world to discuss key issues in international psychology. Participants in the hour-long activity addressed questions about psychology and its role in global health, the contributions of international collaborations, and other critical issues in the field in a broad, cross-border context. The four questions asked as part of the structured networking event are presented below:



- 1. How can we position psychology as a leader in global health?*
- 2. How should national and international psychological associations interact on a global scale to further advance psychology?*
- 3. What key topics should be identified for international collaboration in psychology?*
- 4. How can mutually beneficial partnerships be developed and expanded to benefit psychologists?*

Participant responses offered both specific and broad suggestions for international leaders of psychology to come together across associations, regions, and specializations and develop a shared action plan to advance psychology's role in health and well-being globally.
