

**Today a new edition of the Winter School of the Eramus Mundus Master's Degree in WOP-P will be launched. This year due to the pandemics, it will be carried out virtually being a new challenge for students, teachers and coordination team since the methodology is highly interactive and participatory.**

Over the next two weeks, forty-two students from twenty-two countries from different continents (e.g., Bangladesh, Holland, Panama, Mexico, Colombia, New Zealand, United States, England...) will participate in the intensive phase of the XIV<sup>th</sup> Winter School of Master Eramus Mundus in WOP-P. The last ten editions, the intensive phase of this School has been developed in [the International Center of Gandía](#) and with the collaboration of [the General Foundation of the UV](#). In this edition, due to the socio-health context, the development of this phase will be carried out in a virtual environment with new challenges for students, teachers and coordination team taking into account the methodologies used in the workshop. The opening will take place virtually on February 12 at 3:00 p.m. and Professor David Guest (King College London) will present the inaugural lecture. On Friday, February 26, the closing ceremony will end this in-residence phase of the Winter School.

The main objective of this School is the development of professional competences for the design of interventions in the field of organizations, in an international and transcultural context combining the global and local perspectives.

The coordination team consists of Professor Leonor País (University of Coimbra) Professor Salvatore Zappala (University of Bologna), Professors Carolina Moliner and Isabel Rodríguez (both from University of Valencia) with the support of Dr. Luminita Patras. The faculty is composed of professors from different international universities and includes Prof. Dirk Steiner (University of Cote d'Azur), Prof. Fred Zijlstra (University of Maastricht), Prof. Neil Anderson (University of Bradford, UK), Prof. Rob Briner (Queen Mary, University of London), Prof. Richard Griffith (Florida Tech, USA), Professor Salvatore Zappala (University of Bologna) and Prof. Vicente González-Romá (University of Bologna). The Winter School is coordinated by Prof. José M. Peiró.

The [Master EM in WOP-P](#) is taught by the consortium of four European Universities (Barcelona, Bologna, Coimbra, and Valencia) under the direction of Professor Vicente Martínez-Tur.
