Valencia is the third-largest metropolitan area of Spain. It is located on the eastern coast of the Iberian Peninsula and the western part of the Mediterranean Sea.

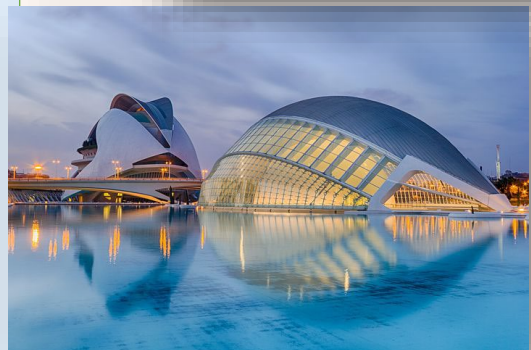

- ...**culture** since it is famous for its architecture, City of Arts and Sciences, cultural projects and worldwide festivals, such as las the [Fallas](#)



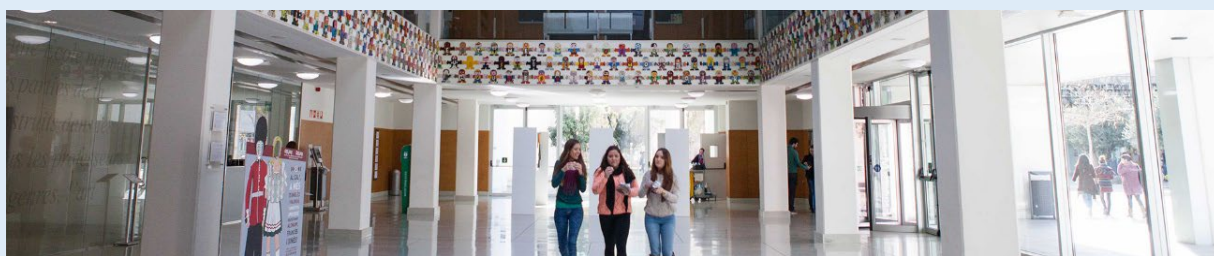

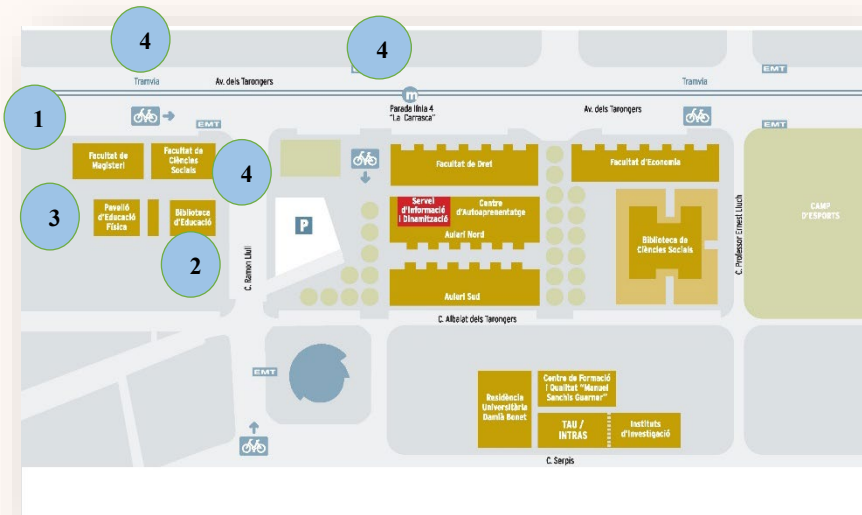

The Faculty location and Facilities

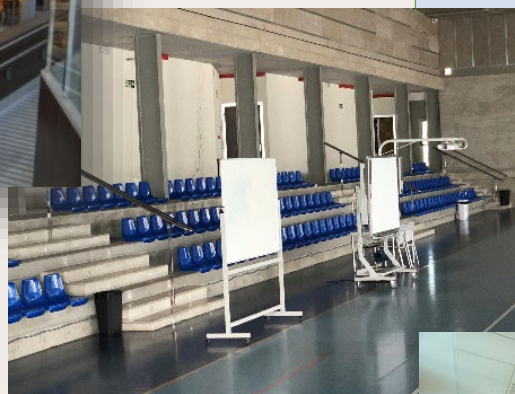
Our Faculty is located on **two campuses**:

The **main one** is the **Tarongers campus of the University of Valencia**. This campus is inside the **city of Valencia**, in an area full of young people and life, including all kinds of restaurants, sports centres and shopping possibilities.



As shown in the picture, the Teachers Training Faculty (Facultat de Magisterio) (1) is next to the **education library María Moliner** (2) and the **campus restaurant** (3). There are **Tram, bus and public bikes** stops to take students anywhere in the city (4). This Faculty also offers:

- An indoor **sports centre**.
- 3 Full equipped **sciences lab**.
- 4 full-equipped **music classrooms**.
- **3 computer/multimedia rooms**.
- An **audio-visual laboratory**.
- **Students area** for individual and group work.
- **44 full-of-light classrooms** provided with white board, projector screen and computer.



The extended campus is located in Ontinyent, about 80 km from Valencia. **The UV Campus Ontinyent** includes the Early Childhood Teacher Degree, having the same curriculum as in the Valencia Campus. More information www.uv.es/ontinyent



The Campus is composed of two buildings:

- **The historic building.** It is an ancient school of the Spanish Republic period. It contains all the facilities for students and teachers: the secretary, the library, the head office, teachers' rooms, seminars, the dining room, the Aula Magna and spaces for meetings.
- **The inter facultative classroom.** It is a modern building of recent construction. It includes 19 classrooms, including specific laboratories in the areas of science, music and body expression, art and computer rooms.



Studies Calendar

In Valencia,

- **The first term** lasts from the **second week of September** to about **December 22**.
- The **first term evaluation period** takes place from about **January 7 to 27**
- **The second term** lasts from about **January 28 to May 19**.
- **The second term evaluation period** takes place from **May 20 to June 9**.

How are our Degrees Structured?

The Teacher Training Faculty in Valencia consist of one component: the four-year Degree. Our Faculty offers two Degrees: The **Early Childhood Teacher Degree** and the **Primary Teacher Degree**. Concerning the former, students can choose their branch of specialisation in their third year, as shown below. Thus, the subjects offered in the first and second years are common across all knowledge branches, whereas those offered in the third and fourth years are related to the chosen specialisation.

Our Master's Degree in Research in Specific Didactics (MUIDE)

The MUIDE provides advanced research training in the specialisations of Teaching Visual Arts, Experimental and Social Science, Physical Education, Language and Literature, Mathematics, and Music. For this, the MUIDE counts on teaching staff recognised for their long research careers and their international prestige. The MUIDE is preferably aimed at: i) Teachers of non-university educational levels who wish to complete their training by acquiring researching competencies, which allow them to perform innovatively or researching educational actions for improving their teaching practice; ii) University graduates who wish to start or continue their university academic career in the areas of knowledge or departments related to the specialties of the MUIDE. After completing the MUIDE successfully, you will have the knowledge and tools of research to be able to access the Doctorate in Specific Didactics of the University of Valencia or equivalent doctorates from other universities.

Our Doctoral Programme in Specific Didactics

The doctoral degree proposed aims to respond to the training needs in the research areas of Specific Didactics. These knowledge areas share a common work of training professional teachers in relevant curriculum areas. This general aim focuses on the following goals: i) to train competent researchers in Specific Didactics, and ii) to provide updated knowledge and methodological training in the main fields of research. This will allow them to design research projects and develop quality research projects; iii) to incorporate new members to the research community in Specific Didactics; iv) to improve the effectiveness and coverage of education through basic and applied research in Specific Didactics, its communication and dissemination among the educational community and the implementation of the results in educational centres.
