## You must:

- a) be a national of a state participating in the programme (or possess a valid residence permit and visa)
- b) be a UV undergraduate student
- c) have completed 42 ECTS credits of your degree before travelling abroad.
- d) not exceed the maximum period of stay (12 months) if you have already benefitted from an Erasmus+ grant, including Erasmus+ traineeships.
- e) demonstrate the language proficiency required by the host university.

It should be noted that Erasmus+ programme is compatible with Erasmus+ traineeships, but not with SICUE or the UV's international programmes of mobility exchange.

## Steps:

- 2) Choose up to five destinations (in order of preference).
- 3) Fill the application form (around November, each year may vary): <a href="http://www.uv.es/portalumne">http://www.uv.es/portalumne</a>
- 4) Attach your language certificate.
- 5) Should you be awarded an Erasmus+ grant, you will be informed of your destination in March. You must accept the grant via the UV's Online Office.
- 6) The remaining procedures will be explained in an information meeting in April.
