You should know...

- Our faculty offers **two degrees**:
 1. Degree in Early Childhood Education
 2. Degree in Primary School Teaching
- The academic year consists of **two semesters**:
 1. **September-January**
 - Lectures begin the second week of September and end on approximately December 22.
 - **The Christmas holidays** are between December 23 and January 6.
 - From January 7, **we enter the exam period** (1st call); **in case of failure, the 2nd call is in June.**
 2. **January-June.**
 - Lectures begin the last week of January and end the third week of May.
 - There are two holiday periods in this term: **the Fallas festival** (between March 15 and 20) and **Holy Week and Easter** (in April approximately). [More info here](#)

DO NOT BOOK YOUR TICKET UNTIL THE EXAM
PERIOD IS OVER!



- **Class attendance is MANDATORY.** Each subject usually has 2 sessions of 2 hours a week.
- **In-person attendance** at examinations is **MANDATORY.** You are not allowed to take exams *online* or outside the period established by the faculty.
- The Faculty of Teacher Training teaches subjects in three languages: Spanish, Valencian/Catalan and English. **The places in the groups in English are limited**, so it is **advisable to improve your Spanish** before coming, since we have more places on offer in subjects in that language. **See the list of subjects taught in English [HERE](#)**
- The University of Valencia is a public and non-denominational institution: **there are no spaces for religious worship.**

ENROLMENT PROCESS

Your **academic mobility coordinator** is:

- **Prof. Silvia Maria Chireac** (silvia.chireac@uv.es) if you are nominated for **Primary education**.
- **Prof. Elia Saneleuterio** (elia.saneleuterio@uv.es) if you are nominated for **Pre-school education**.

Your coordinator **will help you**:



- Solve doubts about the subjects and schedules.
- Sign your academic agreement (LA) before your arrival in Valencia (and when you arrive if you need to make any changes).
- Help you with any academic issues you can't resolve.

THE NEXT STEPS



1. VIEW STUDY PLANS

(If you click on "more info" next to each subject/course, **you will be able to see the groups, language** in which it is taught and **schedules**, and also, on the left, the "teaching guide" with all the contents)

2. SELECT SUBJECTS

Choose the subjects you want to enroll in during the academic year. **Note that:**

VERY IMPORTANT

At least **50% of your ECTS** must belong to the academic offer of the **Faculty of Teacher Training** (Links from the previous point)

For **the subjects that are not taught in our faculty, we cannot guarantee availability of places.** (To see other degrees from other Faculties: www.uv.es > Degree Studies > Choose the Degree > Degree Sheet > Curriculum > Consult information > Teaching guide)

First/second semester students can only **choose** subjects of the first/second semester, **NOT annual, NOT from a different semester. Full year students** can choose annual, first and second semester subjects.

One **semester** students must enrol **between 18 ECTS and 36 ECTS**, and the **full year students between 36 and 72 ECTS.**

ONLY degree subjects (1st cycle) can be included in the **Learning Agreement.**

a. Keep in mind the language and class schedules: AVOID Valencian groups (except if you study Catalan or if you are Italian, because Valencian will be easy for you). Also **AVOID "O" groups**, because they are **taught on the Ontinyent campus (very far from Valencia).**

Keep in mind that **subjects taught in English are in high demand. Enrolment priority** is based on the **filing date of communication to internacional.magisteri@uv.es** of your preferences.

WE RECOMMEND

Subject 33606 Spanish Language for Teachers (6 ECTS)

Even if you don't know Spanish (yet): we have a special curriculum for Erasmus students at level A1 or A2 (you can ask for more information at elia.saneleuterio@uv.es). This subject can be included in your (LA) and will be an opportunity to learn Spanish and make your life and your classes easier here in Valencia. If you have a good level of Spanish you will also enjoy this course, because you will learn and improve the uses of Spanish with Spanish students. Check with your mobility coordinator.

Teaching work practice in schools

In our faculty we have **teaching work practice subjects in schools** in our community. We recommend these subjects

3. SCHEDULE DESIGN, ONLINE PRE-CONTRACT AND LEARNING AGREEMENT (LA)

AVOID OVERLAPS!

PRE-REGISTRATION

1. Organize the chosen subjects. **Ensure compatibility of timetables and location.**
2. Access the enrolment instructions on the website:

3. **Choose only lectures at the Facultat de Magisteri in the city of Valencia, Campus de Tarongers** (not Ontinyent, it is 1 hour away).

LEARNING AGREEMENT (LA)

1. **Include the subjects sent to you by the ORI in your enrolment summary** the Faculty of Teacher Training + those **subjects** that interest you **from other faculties** (these do not require pre-registration, but **we do not guarantee that places are available**).
2. Obtain the signature of **your home coordinator** for validation.
3. **Specify the subject number** and the **group** chosen in your *learning agreement*.
4. **IMPORTANT:** for the process to be completed correctly, your LA must be signed by you and the coordinator of your university and sent to the coordinator of the Faculty of Education: Silvia.chireac@uv.es (Primary)
elia.saneleuterio@uv.es (Pre-school).

Sending the signed LA is a prerequisite for receiving the Erasmus grant.



Before June 15 if you are coming **for the whole year or in the first semester** or **before December 1** if you come for the **second semester** (if you send them later, we cannot guarantee your place in the desired groups)


How to get to the Faculty: Where are we?




