

Dr. **Javier Ordóñez** is a Full Professor of International Economics at the Jaume I University, where he heads up the Institute of International Economics (IEI). He is president of the Spanish Association of International Economics and Finance (AEEFI). He has taught at the University of Bath in the United Kingdom and the University of Copenhagen in Denmark, and has also been a visiting professor at the University of Nottingham, the University of Bologna, the University of California Davis, the University of Paris 13, the Sapienza University of Rome, the University of Sheffield and the KDI School of Public Policy and Management, among others. Professor Ordóñez received a PhD in Economics (cum laude) from Jaume I University, with European Doctorate accreditation. He holds an MSc in Economics and Finance from the University of Warwick, UK. His key research interests are economic integration, time series econometrics, and unemployment, although he has also published papers in the field of energy economics and regional economics. He has published numerous articles in JCR-indexed journals such as *Empirical Economics*, *Economic Modeling*, *Review of International Economics*, *Energy Economics*, *Energy Journal*, *China Economic Review*, *International Review of Economics and Finance*, *Energy*, *Plos One*, *Open Economies Review*, *Empirica*, and *Regional Studies*, among others, and has contributed chapters to books published by MIT University Press, Routledge and Palgrave Macmillan. He has been guest editor of *Economic Modeling*, *The World Economy* and *The Energy Journal* and he is editor of *Plos One* and *The Asian Journal of Economics and Finance*.
