

## REGISTRATIONS INSTRUCTIONS 2024-25

## BEFORE STARTING THE REGISTRATION PROCESS:

**1. SUBJECTS OF THE FACULTY OF PHILOLOGY, TRANSLATION, AND COMMUNICATION (FFTic):**

- Before registration day, you must look up the codes, names, groups, and subgroups (if applicable) of the subjects taught at FFTiC for which you plan to register, as well as check the schedule. This information is available on our website: <https://links.uv.es/04f3aWi>
- Please note that classes at UV are conducted in person. When creating your schedule, make sure there are no scheduling conflicts, meaning that no two classes overlap on the same day and time.
- Since places in each group are limited, it is advisable to have alternative, compatible options prepared for the same time slot in case your preferred subject is full. You will only be able to register for subjects and groups with available places, even if these courses were included in your learning agreement.

- **Important:** A subject may have different groups (schedules), and each group/subgroup may be taught in a different language. Be sure to check the language before selecting your group.

**DEADLINE:** registration will be online, from January 23<sup>rd</sup> (09:00h) to February 6<sup>th</sup> (22:00h).

Once you have completed your registration, you will be able to access the system again to make modifications—such as adding or dropping subjects or changing groups—if vacancies are available, until 06/02/2025 (22:00h).

**Before closing the application, it is necessary to validate and confirm the registration.**
