

MASTER IN ARCHAEOLOGY. COURSE 2026-2027

The ranking process for admission to the 2026/27 academic year will be carried out according to the following criteria:

1. Average grade of the undergraduate academic record, weighted according to the degree of relevance of the qualification.

2. Degrees:

- Relevant degree (BA in History, BA in Archaeology, and BA in Geography and History) = 1 point.
- BA in Geography, Humanities, Art History, Anthropology, Philosophy, Fine Arts, Conservation and Restoration, and equivalent degrees = 0.75 points.
- Degree in Architecture, Fine Arts, Visual Arts, and equivalent higher education qualifications = 0.50 points.
- Other higher education qualifications = 0.33 points.

3. Motivation letter: up to 1 point.

4. Professional experience: up to 1 point. Relevance to the Master's programme will be taken into account

5. Training courses: up to 1 point. Relevance to the Master's programme will be taken into account.

6. Languages:

- Valencian A1 or equivalent* = 0.2 points.
- English, French, Basque, Galician, German, or Italian A1 or equivalent* = 0.1 points.
- Valencian A2 or equivalent* = 0.4 points.
- English, French, Basque, Galician, German, or Italian A2 or equivalent* = 0.2 points.
- Valencian B1 or equivalent* = 0.6 points.
- English, French, Basque, Galician, German, or Italian B1 or equivalent* = 0.3 points.
- Valencian B2 or equivalent* = 0.8 points.
- English, French, Basque, Galician, German, or Italian B2 or equivalent* = 0.4 points.
- Valencian C1 or equivalent* = 1 point.
- English, French, Basque, Galician, German, or Italian C1 or equivalent* = 0.5 points.
- Valencian C2 or equivalent* = 1.2 points.
- English, French, Basque, Galician, German, or Italian C2 or equivalent* = 0.6 points.
- Other languages will be valued at 0.05 points per level*.

7. Interview: conducted only if deemed necessary by the Selection Committee: up to 1 point.

8. Letter of recommendation: up to 1 point.

9. Curriculum vitae.

- Archaeological excavations: 0.5 points per participation, up to a maximum of 1 point.
- Courses and seminars: 0.1 points per attendance, up to a maximum of 1 point.
- Scholarships:
 - o Erasmus scholarship: 0.2 points.
 - o Collaboration scholarship: 0.5 points.
- Publications:
 - o Up to 0.5 points per publication, with a maximum of 2 points.
- Additional undergraduate degree beyond that submitted for admission: 0.5 points.
- Additional Master's degree beyond that submitted for admission: 0.33 points.

10. Other criteria (First-choice application): 5 points.

Supporting documentation for all merits must be submitted at the time of pre-registration. Otherwise, such merits cannot be taken into consideration.
