**SUMMARY**

Educational Guidance is a relevant subject within the curriculum of the Bachelor's Degree in Pedagogy. This discipline provides students with the theoretical and practical foundations necessary to develop their professional competencies. Theory serves as the scientific basis for practice, while the practical component helps identify and apply the most appropriate guidance approach in each case.

Its contribution to the training of educational counselors for the development of their professional duties means that this subject must be understood from a dual perspective: personal and professional. The aim is to enable students to acquire not only scientific and technical knowledge, but also the pedagogical aptitudes, skills, abilities, and attitudes necessary to practice the profession of Counselor with an appropriate level of competence.

The Counselor is seen as a committed professional, not only in providing support in situations of deficit (therapeutic function), but above all, in the overall improvement of the educational process and the social system in which this process takes place (functions of prevention, development, and intervention). These principles of intervention must guide both theory and practice.

**TEACHING METHODOLOGY**

The methodology to be followed will combine, depending on the type of activity carried out (theoretical class, practical class, case resolution, tutoring), the following working modalities: teacher exposition, collaborative learning, student case presentation, case-based learning, dialogic readings, debates, and activity resolution.

**Theoretical Classes:**

They will be dedicated to the analysis, study, and understanding of the fundamental concepts included in the course syllabus. The more complex concepts will be explained by the teaching staff and, to encourage student involvement and participation, each theoretical class will include the resolution of exercises and/or complementary activities by the students, as well as dialogic pedagogical discussions, critical reflection activities, and collaborative activities using scientific platforms that help consolidate the subject knowledge.

**Practical Classes:**

Practical classes will focus on the resolution and correction of relevant practical cases, closely linked to everyday reality and previously grounded in the theoretical context of the subject. The resolution of practical cases may be carried out individually or in small groups. These practices will form the basis for each student to prepare their own practice dossier.

**Individual Study:**

It is oriented towards autonomous learning activities for the student. The applied model is the researcher



one, where the student's activity focuses on researching, locating, analyzing, elaborating, and returning information.

**Tutoring:**

Tutoring is offered for problem-solving, guidance, and supervision of work, etc. Tutoring via email is also contemplated, as well as tutored libraries as an extension of learning time at the end of the course for resolving doubts and study support.

## EVALUATION

The assessment of the student's competencies will be carried out through a combination of different types of information linked to the various activities that the students will develop in the course. To ensure the acquisition and development of competencies (whether knowledge-based, procedural, or attitudinal), various assessment procedures will be used, adapted to the activities carried out by the students.

**Exam:** Completion of a written and/or objective test that will evaluate the theoretical and practical application of all the content covered throughout the course.

**Practice notebook:** Includes practical cases developed in the classroom, which can be completed individually or in groups, as well as fieldwork and other related activities.

**Classroom activities:** Completion and submission of activities during class sessions, active participation in the various proposed activities, as well as in external activities, self-learning questionnaires, and other educational resources.

Each of these activities will be assigned a percentage of the final grade according to its importance, which will be explained in class and made available on the course Moodle during the first week.

The grading system will be expressed by a numeric grade in accordance with the regulations (RD 1125/2003 of September 5), which establishes the European Credit Transfer System and the grading system for official university degrees valid throughout the national territory.



Students who cannot attend the course in person may take it remotely with a justified cause. These students must contact the course instructor during the first month of the course to justify their absence and learn about the assessment modality
