The possibility of autopràcticum is contemplated when the student himself seeks and submit your application to a particular enterprise, application which must be approved by the academic tutor

These activities are regulated by a cooperation framework agreement signed between the University of Valencia Cooperation, company, institution or entity that receives the student and the University-Enterprise of Valencia (ADEIT) Foundation.



The ADEIT places awarded to applicants students, appearing in them his (subject teacher) academic tutor and a tutor of the enterprise tutor

Educational methodology

Presencial Activities:

In the Center of Practices the students, with the tutor's orientation, will develop the tasks marked in the respective program, in order to acquire the skills offered in every program.

Tutorships:

Profile of the tutor: The professional from the company, institution or entity that appears in the "Practicum" tutoring in the Agreement or Annex must be in possession of a higher university degree, which may coincide with that of the student or be related to it.

Requirements of the tutor: The professional from the company, institution or entity that appears in the "Practicum" tutoring must meet the following requirements:

- Be part of the collaborating company or institution, have professional experience and the necessary knowledge to carry out effective tutoring.
- Not coincide with the person who performs the functions of academic tutor.
- Meet the additional requirements that may be established by the Center's Practicum Committee.

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EVALUATION



Evaluation

The 6 *ECTS* credits of this matter of study will be recognized when at least the 80% of all the presencial activities, marked in the formative program, have been realized.

The competences will be evaluated in relation by the proposed goals, depending on:

- The final report of the practices, written and presented by the students.
- The final report of the external tutor.
- The valuation of the academic tutor.

Complementary activities will be 10% of the final grade.

The academic tutor, responsible for the matter, will evaluate the realized work, with the follow-up of the practices in mind, as well as the reports previously mentioned. More information about the procedures of evaluation is included in the "Guide of the External Practices students"

The second summons of the evaluation will be abided by the same criteria.
