DESCRIPTION OF CONTENTS

The objective of the Final Project is to apply the knowledge, skills, and competencies acquired by the student during the Bachelor's degree through the development and defense of a project in the field of Economics.

In the project, the student must identify a relevant economic problem, pose one or more questions, address it with appropriate information and methodology, and formulate relevant conclusions or recommendations. Alternatively, the student may complete a Final Project linked to the Internship.

1. General issues

The TFG will be composed of three parts:

- 1.- The project
- 2.- Personal assessment of the Degree.
- 3.- Curriculum Vitae.

2. The Project. Personal Assessment of the Degree. Curriculum Vitae

Regarding the project, the following general structure is proposed for the preparation of the Final Degree Project. The Introduction should present the justification of the topic, the current status of the object of analysis, the objectives of the Final Degree Project, and the hypothesis to be investigated. The main body of the project should review the academic literature to establish a theoretical framework. The materials used should be explained: data, surveys, and general sources. The analytical tools used that are relevant to the study should be described. Depending on the objective, the methodology to be followed is presented. The Results should be presented, which can be supported by graphs and tables. The Conclusions should be presented as a summary of the Final Degree Project. Finally, the Bibliography section should provide an overview of the existing literature on the topic covered.



Personal assessment of the degree

The student must make an assessment of the Degree: what it has meant for him/her at a formative level, the aspects that could be improved and the positive aspects. This evaluation must be made in a constructive spirit and inappropriate or pejorative language will not be accepted.

The maximum length will be 400 words.

Curriculum Vitae

Brief CV specifying the average grade of the credits passed, the level of accredited languages, academic stays abroad and professional experience.

3. Collaboration and confidentiality

As set out in the regulations of the University of Valencia (article 4, points 4 and 5), the TFG can be carried out in collaboration with other institutions, organizations or companies different from the University of Valencia, with which there is an agreement. In this case, it is necessary to specify, beforehand, if there were restrictions that, for reasons of confidentiality, could prevent the publication of some results of the work carried out.

4. Intellectual property owner and responsibility

Once finalized, the TFG is the property of the student, who assumes the authorship of the work carried out and is solely responsible for the opinions and value judgments that may appear from the reading of the work
