They consist of carrying out practical activities in companies, government services and other institutions related to cultural heritage that have signed a "Acord de Col·laboració" with the University of Valencia.

Students, teaching staff and administration and services staff have at their disposal a detailed information document on the Master's course (published annually and delivered at the beginning of the academic year) and which includes the conditions of coordination and evaluation of the External Internships.

Each speciality, in order to ensure general coordination between the different activities programmed, as well as the homogenisation of the evaluation criteria, will have a teacher in charge who will be, whenever possible, the coordinator of each speciality.
