Academic internships are an educational activity carried out by students and supervised by a tutor from the institution where they are carried out and by an academic tutor from the University of Valencia. Its main objective is to allow students to apply and complement the knowledge acquired in their academic training, while promoting the acquisition of skills that prepare them for the exercise of professional activities, facilitate their employability and foster their entrepreneurial capacity.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

The organization and management of external internships for students at the University of Valencia is the responsibility of the University-Business Foundation, ADEIT. The Framework Internship Agreement is the document that establishes, where applicable, the general conditions for carrying out external academic internships by students at the University of Valencia in a company or institution. In the case of the Master in Economic Internationalization, internships must be paid unless they are in companies or public entities of relevance.

A.- SELF-PRACTICUM process

Students must try to find a suitable company for the internship themselves. The student must submit a form to the Academic Committee (CCA) with the organization's details so that it can approve the company and the functions to be performed there.

Once the offer has been approved by the CCA and the candidate has been accepted by the company, the AUTOPRACTICUM form will be sent to ADEIT and the Internship Agreement will be formalized. This establishes the activities to be carried out, assigns tutors, within the company and at the University, and agrees on the start and end dates and the overall duration of the student's stay at the company.



B.- Selection process through ADEIT- University and Business Foundation.

Students who do not opt for the Autopracticum process will participate in the ordinary internship selection process. Through the University and Business Foundation - ADEIT of the University of Valencia, a pool of companies that meet the requirements indicated by the Academic Coordination Committee of the Master will be offered.

The student will choose the internship that interests him/her most based on an order determined by the average grades obtained in the first year of the master's degree.

Once the selection of companies has been made, and the university tutors have been assigned by the CCA, ADEIT will formalize the corresponding Internship agreements.

C. Application for recognition of work placements for related work activity

If the student is working under an employment contract in a company performing duties related to the contents of the master's degree, he or she may request the CCA to validate the work placements in a company for work activity. The registration process will be the same as in the previous cases.

EVALUATION

The evaluation of the External Internships will be carried out in parallel to that of the Master's Final Project (given the link between the two), taking into account the latter, the results offered by the student in his/her professional activity and the assessment of the professional tutor of the company or institution in which the Internships were carried out.
