The work should reflect the student's ability to apply and develop the knowledge gained during the program.

The Master's Thesis may take the form of a theoretical and/or empirical study on a problem or aspect related to corporate finance, or a practical project addressing a specific issue applied to a particular company. The Master's Thesis may be based on the project carried out by the student during their external internship (Internship in a company).
