The internships are not work-related, but academic in nature. Its purpose is for the student to get to know the institutional, business and labour reality of their environment in the field of their profession, and at the same time gain valuable professional experience. The wealth of nuances of business reality can never be matched by the typical restrictions of the classroom, which is why the aim is for students to gain an edifying experience in private companies and public institutions, allowing them to apply their previous knowledge and broaden their skills.

DESCRIPTION OF CONTENTS

Internships

Students will complete a minimum of 180 hours of internship at a company of their choice from among those participating and collaborating with the master's programme and which have notified ADEIT accordingly. However, students may seek a company and undertake a self-directed internship, provided that they meet the requirements and are able to sign up to the UV internship agreement.

The selection criteria is the order determined by the weighted average of the master's degree grades corresponding to the first semester.

**Internship report**

Upon completion of the internship, students must write an internship report and submit it to their academic tutor.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

The course consists of 6 compulsory credits. The subject consists of two clearly differentiated parts: the company placement and the completion of an internship report.

The company placement: The course will allow students to carry out a work placement in an organisation in order to carry out a specific project in the company, directed simultaneously by an academic tutor and a person of reference in the company. The minimum duration will be 180 hours spent on the premises of the company. The internship will be carried out in a period to be determined between April and July.

The dates established are considered to be a maximum to be respected, and may be reduced depending on the availability of the work placement agency and the student in each particular case. Nevertheless, strict compliance with the duration established above must be observed.

Work placement report: After the student's stay in the company, he/she will write and hand in a report on his/her participation in the quality management project carried out by the company. The student's personal work is estimated at 45 hours.

The report must have, as a minimum, the following structure:



Introduction

Company profile Quality management approach followed by the company

Quality management project in which the company is immersed when the student starts the work placement

Project in which the student participates Description of the department in which the internship has been carried out. Description of the specific tasks carried out by the student in the project.

For the processing of information through the use of Generative Artificial Intelligence (GAI) tools, the following considerations must be taken into account:

¿ As a general rule, GAI tools may not be used to achieve the main objective of assessment activities

¿ Teachers will explicitly indicate under what conditions and for what type of activities the use of GAI is permitted or restricted.

¿ If the student uses any GAI tools, they must indicate this in the work submitted.

They will include a footnote or an appendix containing the prompt used, its various modifications and a fragment of the most relevant text from the response.

EVALUATION

To pass the work placement task, the student must present the work placement report in pdf format in the centre's virtual classroom.

The project report must be signed by the student, the academic tutor and the company tutor.

The justification of the completion of the 180 internships in the company and the assessment of the company tutor will be sent to the academic tutor through ADEIT.

DEADLINE:

1st call: 7th July 2025.

2nd call: 15 September 2025.

The mark for the course will be made up of the assessment of the company tutor, the assessment of the academic tutor and the mark obtained in the report.
