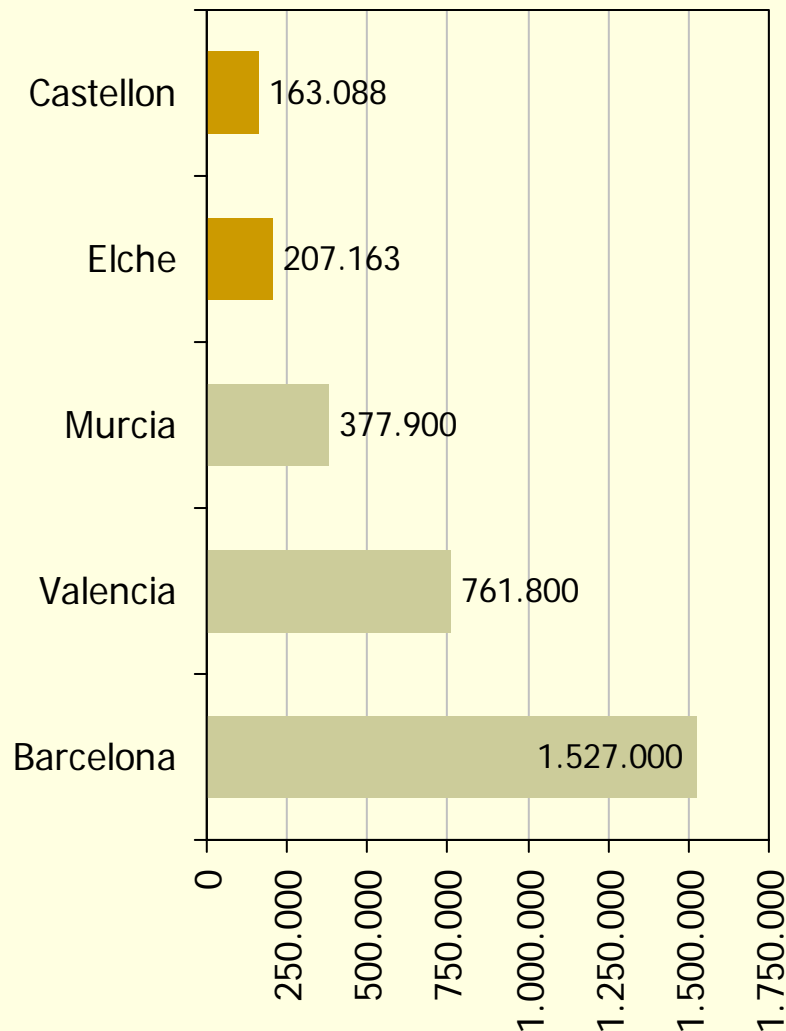
# Project objectives

  - To detect the main problems & solutions in several EU cities
  - To exchange experiences between experts from several EU countries
  
- The final result:
  - A guide of advices and "best practices" in order to implement / improve the systems that deal with the monitoring of traffic accidents in urban areas.

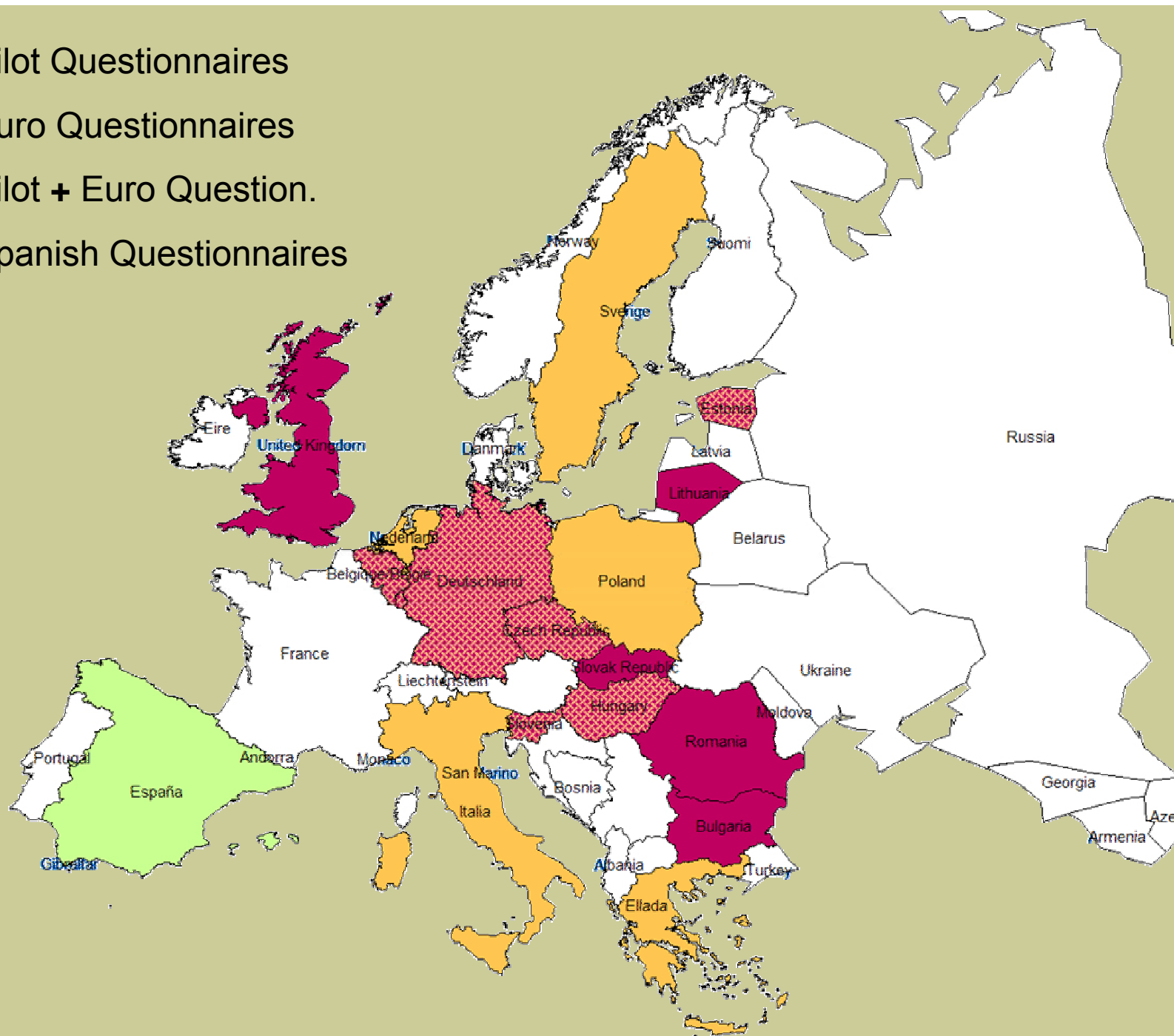


# Participants in the “survey study”
