### Call for Papers

We are delighted to announce the Call for Papers for the MultiEDU: 1st International Conference on Multilingual and Cross-disciplinary Education, organised within the framework of the research project English as a vehicular language for multidisciplinary teaching in the Valencian Community (EVELMUT), funded by the Universitat de València (UV-INV-AE25-4227375). The conference, which will be conducted in a hybrid modality, will feature plenary lectures by Martine Derivry-Plard (Maison des Sciences Humaines de Bordeaux, France), Lee Ann Bussolari (Bilingual Educator, IBEN (PYP/MYP), MIE Expert, NEASC visitor) and David Bradshaw (Cambridge University Press & Assessment).

This conference aims to bring together researchers, teacher educators, and secondary school teachers interested in multilingual education, particularly in CLIL (Content and Language Integrated Learning), EMI (English-Medium Instruction), and ESP (English for Specific Purposes) contexts by:

- Analysing current practices in multilingual and cross-disciplinary education.
- Exploring the training needs of teachers in CLIL/EMI contexts.
- Promoting the integration of emerging technologies in language and content teaching.
- Sharing innovative teaching practices across secondary and higher education.
- Strengthening collaboration between schools, universities, and institutions.

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- CLIL and EMI practices in secondary and higher education.
- Cross-disciplinary approaches to teaching through English.
- Teacher training and professional development in multilingual contexts.
- Digital competence and technology-enhanced language learning.
- Artificial Intelligence in education.
- Virtual Exchange and internationalisation at home.
- Inclusive and accessible multilingual education.
- Materials development for CLIL/EMI.
- Assessment in multilingual and cross-disciplinary settings.
- Socio-emotional and intercultural competences in multilingual education.
- Educational responses to emergency or disruptive teaching contexts.

#### Types of contributions

- Oral presentations (20 minutes + 10-minute discussion)
- Posters

#### Submission guidelines

Abstracts should be between 250 and 300 words and must be submitted via the designated [online submission form](#). Each presenter may participate in a maximum of two presentations, and each presentation may include no more than two presenters. Submissions are accepted in English, Spanish, or Catalan.

The abstracts must contain the following information:

**Background:** Contextualisation of the research problem and its relevance within the field.

**Objectives:** Clear articulation of research aims, hypotheses, or guiding questions.

**Methodology:** Brief but sufficiently precise description of methodological approach, data sources, and analytical procedures.

**Results:** Summary of principal findings, emphasising empirical or theoretical contributions.

**Conclusions:** Interpretation of results, including implications for research, practice, or policy.

**Keywords:** Provide 5 keywords that facilitate indexing and thematic classification.

References (optional): Maximum 10.
