If you are an incoming student with a disability, medical condition that affects your studies, or special educational needs, the **UVdisability** support service is here to assist you.

Our goal is to guarantee equal access to education for all students.

UVdisability provides assistance according to your needs, including:

- Personalized guidance and support throughout your stay.
- Coordination of academic adjustments and accessibility.
- Report to teachers about your needs.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Who can apply to UVdisability?

Any student with a recognized disability, medical condition or specific educational needs can request support from UVDisability.

2. How do I apply for adjustments?

To request adjustments, you must contact our service by email at **updestudiantes@uv.es** prior to your arrival. We will assist you throughout the entire application process and provide guidance on the necessary documentation.

You will be required to provide official documentation from a certified medical professional confirming your disability, medical condition, or special educational needs. Additionally, you must submit a report from your home university outlining the support measures or adjustments currently in place for you.

Requests for adjustments must be submitted by the following deadlines:

First semester: October 31stSecond semester: March 31st

3. Will my adjustments be the same as at my home university?

Not necessarily. We will evaluate your needs and coordinate the most suitable adjustments within the framework of the University of Valencia's resources and regulations.

4. Can I get support for exams?

Yes, we provide adjustments such as extended time, adapted formats, and assistive technology for exams. We kindly ask you to discuss your needs with us prior to your arrival.

5. Are all university buildings accessible?

Most buildings are accessible, but some older structures may have limitations. We recommend informing us about your mobility needs in advance so that we can provide the best possible assistance.

Common Adjustments at University of Valencia

The following are some of the **most frequently requested adjustments** at the University of Valencia:

- ✓ Extended time for exams.
- ✓ Alternative exam formats (oral, digital, etc.)
- ✓ Accessible course materials (braille, enlarged text, digital formats, etc.)
- ✓ Use of assistive technology and specialized software depending on the needs
 of the student.
- ✓ Physical accessibility adaptations in classrooms and laboratories.

If you need adjustments that are not listed here, we encourage you to contact us as soon as possible to discuss your needs.

Below is a list of adjustments that are not permitted at the University of Valencia:

- X Access to lectures online.
- X Use of spellchecker during the exams.
- **X** Use of mind maps, visual diagrams, schemes or mathematical forms during the exams.
